COMPONENT I

IMPROVE KNOWLEDGE OF LEGAL REMEDIES

RESULT 1.1: PARTNER CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS, PROFESSIONAL ORGANIZATIONS AND GOVERNMENT PARTNERS LAUNCH STRATEGIC COMMUNICATION CAMPAIGNS THAT EFFECTIVELY DELIVER PRIORITY ACCESS TO JUSTICE MESSAGES TO TARGETED VULNERABLE POPULATIONS

On October 24, **Hiyad Organization** conducted a one-day workshop for widows and divorcees about the legal and social rights of women (including alimony, custody, divorce and social security). The workshop was held in Al-Faw district of Basrah and was attended by 30 women. Most of the attendees were divorcees who live in very poor conditions and need legal assistance. On October 25, Hiyad broadcast a 30-minute radio call-in program, which received complaints and inquiries on women's rights and social services directed toward central and local government. Callers directed their questions to the show's guest, the head of the Basrah Provincial Committee for Women and Family.

Harikar broadcast a one-hour call-in program on October 25 on Dahuk Radio, the third in a series of radio programs under the A2J grant. The Director of Nojeen Organization in Dahuk was the show's guest, who discussed the role of civil society in assisting and providing services to internally displaced persons (IDPs).

Civil Development Organization (CDO) conducted a two-day awareness session for 21 women on October 17 and 18. The session, which was conducted by lawyer Lana Hiwa and social worker Lamiaa Sadiq, was designed to raise women's legal and social awareness. During the training, the lawyer explained the personal status law, the articles that support women's rights and other articles that do not clearly recognize women's rights.

COMPONENT 2

IMPROVE LEGAL EDUCATION AND SERVICES

RESULT 2.1: SUPPORT IRAQI NGOs WORKING IN PRIORITY ACCESS TO JUSTICE AREAS TO IMPROVE THEIR ADMINISTRATIVE AND SUBSTANTIVE CAPACITY TO SUPPORT VULNERABLE POPULATIONS

On October 23, A2J conducted an unscheduled site visit to **Women for Justice (WFJ)**, a partner providing legal assistance to vulnerable women and war victims in Karbala. The purpose of the visit was to monitor compliance with Program requirements. WFJ's performance is consistent with project plans and needs, resulting in positive outcomes. A2J focused on the critical areas that, if performed well, significantly improve project outcomes. A2J noted improvements in grantee documentation after guidance provided during a previous site visit. To date, WFJ has provided 518 consultations and legal representation for 249 clients. The majority of WFJ cases have been related to social welfare and alimony.

RESULT 2.2: WORK WITH IRAQI LEGAL PROFESSIONAL ASSOCIATIONS TO INCREASE ADMINISTRATIVE AND SUBSTANTIVE CAPACITIES FOR EMPOWERING LAWYERS AND OTHER LEGAL PROFESSIONALS TO ASSIST VULNERABLE OR DISADVANTAGE POPULATIONS

On October 23 and 24, A2J and the Iraqi Bar Association (IBA) completed two practical skills-based trainings for lawyers. The training covered pleading and evidence procedures for civil cases, as well as a mock trial of the personal status issues that have proven important to vulnerable groups. The participants were split into small groups and worked on cases involving marriage certification, paternity and divorce. Both trainings were attended by the IBA chairman. The training was attended each day by 30 young lawyers (17 men, 13 women).

RESULT 2.4: SUPPORT DEVELOPMENT OF PROGRAMS AND MODERNIZATION OF ACADEMIC AND PRACTICAL CURRICULUM RELATED TO EXTENDING ACCESS TO JUSTICE TO VULNERABLE POPULATIONS AT LAW SCHOOLS IN IRAQI UNIVERSITIES IN KEY LOCATIONS THROUGHOUT IRAQ

A2J continues preparing for the Jessup Moot Court National Competition, scheduled for January 2013. The legal research and writing trainings, with accompanying handouts and PowerPoint slides, have been completed and finalized, and a full rehearsal (for timing purposes) has been staged. The team is coordinating with local counterparts and the International Law Students Association (ILSA), and has reached out to U.S. nationals in Erbil to serve as judges. Mr. Hadi al Kindi (A2J Basrah) and Mr. Salah Saeed (A2J Erbil) will review the materials and finalize the Jessup timeline.

COMPONENT 3

ADVOCACY AND IMPROVED GOVERNMENT SERVICES

RESULT 3.1: SUPPORT PARTNERS IN REVIEWING PROCESSES AND PROCEDURES FOR REFORM OF POLICIES, REGULATIONS AND LEGISLATION AS THEY RELATE TO VULNERABLE POPULATIONS

In preparation for an upcoming advocacy meeting with **Fatima House**, A2J prepared data gathered by its legal clinics and the Interior Ministry's Community Police to understand the scope of the problem of missing husbands and its impact on Iraq's widows. A2J will provide substantiated, rather than anecdotal, evidence to support the position that this is a serious problem requiring procedural change. In an effort led by Fatima House, A2J will support their presentation of the findings to the Council of Representatives Human Rights Committee on November 8.

Preparations are well underway for the November 10 roundtable discussion in Basrah on how regional authorities can improve the procedures and processes relevant to IDPs. Around 32 attendees are expected from CSOs, the Basrah Provincial Council and the Migration Directorate. The objective of the roundtable is a consensus on recommendations for the Provincial Council and the executive agencies.

RESULT 3.2: POSITIVE LINKAGES TO SUPPORT GOVERNMENT EFFORTS TO IMPROVE LEGAL FRAMEWORKS FOR VULNERABLE POPULATIONS

On October 31 the A2J Basrah Regional Director met with the Chairman of the Public Relations and Civil Society Institutions Committee at the Basrah Provincial Council, Mr. Hasan Al-Rashed. During the meeting, the Chairman was provided with a brief introduction to A2J and its mission. The chairman expressed his Committee's appreciation of the work done by international actors, especially USAID, which in his opinion has offered a great deal of support to the people of Iraq. He emphasized the importance of engaging the Committee in the upcoming roundtable and other events so that the Committee can work together with Program grantees to find solutions to ensure the provision of the best possible legal services for vulnerable populations.
