**COMPONENT 1 - IMPROVE KNOWLEDGE OF LEGAL REMEDIES**

**Result 1.1: Partner CSOs, Professional Organizations, and Government Partners Launch Strategic Communication Campaign That Effectively Delivers Priority Access to Justice Messages to Targeted Vulnerable Populations**

Sayed Al-Shuhdaa Organization for Social Development completed a workshop on July 8 on the legal rights of divorced women and widows. The event was held at the organization’s hall located in the Qibla District in Basrah and attended by 36 women.



The Iraqi Center for Human Rights Activists (ICHRA) held an awareness-raising workshop in the Shat Al-Arab District on July 11. Twenty-five women (12 widows, 13 divorcees) attended the workshop on legal rights for divorced and widowed women.



Hiyad Organization for Legal and Media Development conducted their second legal awareness workshop on July 11 at one of the Mercy Corps Awareness and Inclusion Centers (also known as “literacy centers”) for women in Abu Al-Khaseeb in the Basrah Province. Twenty-five women participated in this workshop to learn about their legal rights provided under Iraqi Law. The workshop focused on alimony and custody rights over children.





### 1.2.1: Awareness Campaign sponsored by Access to Justice Program to improve knowledge and access to legal rights in the target vulnerable groups in Iraq

East Studio for Arts produced the campaign draft printings for brochures and billboards and the radio, TV programs contents and spots scripts. A2J provided comments to improve the campaign draft printings. East Studio sent the radio and TV programs contents to the Ministries of Justice in Baghdad and KRG to get comments and to make sure that the contents are in accordance with Iraqi law. East Studio is working on advancing the music tune which will be used as background tune for all radio and TV products. All final products will be sent to A2J next week for final review and approval.

### Result 1.4: Effective Monitoring and Evaluation of Implementing Partner Public Awareness Campaigns

**Perception Survey:** Relief International (RI) conducted four focus group discussions (FGD) in Baghdad, Najaf, Kirkuk and Diwaniyah. The groups were asked about perceptions of justice, human rights and vulnerable groups' access to rights. The participants confirmed that the survey that RI is conducting is important as a trusted source of information to be used in scientific researches, laws amendments and as a base for awareness raising campaigns.

RI issued official letters to ministries and provincial councils to facilitate implementation of the survey, which started this week in all provinces. Thirty-eight trained Assessment Officers are working in the field to gather the data.

## COMPONENT 2 - IMPROVE LEGAL EDUCATION AND SERVICES

### Result 2.1: Support Iraqi NGOs Working in Priority Access to Justice Areas to Improve their Administrative and Substantive Capacity to Support Vulnerable Populations

A2J Basra completed a site visit to Sayed Al-Shuda'a Legal Clinic on July 7 in Basra. The program provided technical assistance on case classification, coding systems, proper forms of documentation for tracking cases, filling M&E forms, and proper use of power of attorney, and client confidentiality. To date, the Sayed Al-Shuhda'a legal clinic has received 7 legal consultations and is representing 16 clients.

A2J completed a site visit to Al-Taqwa Association in Basrah on July 8. The program provided technical assistance on documentation, including case completion and legal assistance forms and supporting materials. A2J also explained how to complete weekly and monthly reports. To date, Al-Taqwa legal clinic has received 28 consultations and representing 16 clients.

*Success Story*

H.S., a teenage girl from Basrah, was experiencing problems in her marriage caused by her husband's alcohol abuse. As the problem went unchecked, her husband ended up religiously divorcing her without an official court decision. She was forced to return to live with her family, but her father, who was poor, could not financially support her.

H.S. heard from a neighbor about the Sayed Al-Shuhada's legal clinic and the services it offers to women who need legal representation and advice. She went to the clinic and met with a lawyer. The lawyer assisted in obtaining an official divorce, and the legal clinic is further assisting her in changing her ID status so she will qualify for social security benefits with the Ministry of Labor and Social Affairs.

**Result 2.2: Work with Iraqi legal professional associations (primarily the Iraqi Bar Association and Jurist Union and their subsidiaries) to increase administrative and substantive capacity for empowering lawyers and other legal professional to assist vulnerable or disadvantaged populations**

A2J completed a site visit to the IBA on July 10 in Baghdad to review the content of the training materials the IBA will be present at the upcoming A2J partner meeting.

**Result 2.3: Assist the IBA and other legal associations to “increase the supply” of lawyers assisting vulnerable or disadvantaged populations through initiatives such as continuing legal education (CLE) for lawyers, pre-service and orientation training for new lawyers, and targeted training on assisting specific vulnerable groups**

The Kurdistan Bar Association (KBA) will conduct a fifth capacity building training for new lawyers. The KBA made use of social media as a way to advertise to potential participants. They announced the training course through Facebook, to which 150 lawyers responded. Twenty of them were selected to attend the training which will be held on Saturday, July 14.

**COMPONENT 3 - ADVOCACY AND IMPROVED GOVERNMENT SERVICES**

**Result 3.1: Support Partners in Reviewing Processes and Procedures for Reform of Policies, Regulations, and Legislation as they Relate to Vulnerable Populations.**

In an effort to reduce the burdens on widows who have lost their husbands to violence, A2J supported a meeting with Fatema House, members of the Parliamentary Human Rights Committee and the Women’s Committee, and the Shoura Council to discuss recommended improvements to government processes and laws that would positively affect access to rights for widows. Namely, due to current government procedures, it can take upwards of 10 years before a missing husband is declared deceased, during which time his children may fall into begging and truancy, and his widow may live a life of extreme poverty.

The Parliamentarians indicated they needed more information on the scope of the problem, and discussed the possibilities of polling, specialist analysis, and further meetings. The Program will support Fatema House with legal drafting, polling, and next steps in this advocacy process.

A2J Erbil conducted a site visit to KURDS to assess progress and provide technical advice. KURDS has prepared a survey form, which was developed with the help of A2J, for use in gathering data as a part of advocacy workshops they are holding for disabilities rights. Survey samples are 100 people, in which 50% are female. The results of the survey will be the baseline for determining the focus of three advocacy workshops that KURDS will conduct in the three provinces of KRG in September.

KURDS organized a meeting of NGOs who work in the area of rights of persons with disabilities in Dohuk on Thursday, June 28 at the Dohuk Province Governor’s office. These NGOs provide support to persons with disabilities through various assistance programs in addition to raising awareness in their community as to the needs and rights of persons with disabilities. The aim of the meeting was to share information on the various NGO approaches and their contributions to supporting persons with disabilities.
