1.2. Number of applications lodged to court instances

160 application were lodged from 1/07/2011 to 31/12/2012, videlicet:

45 – establishment of legally relevant facts, including:

- 5 – establishment of the fact of the possession of a house room by the right of ownership
- 11 – establishment of the fact of receiving wages at a fixed rate
- 4 – establishment of the fact of death
- 3 – establishment of the fact of living in dependence
- 5 - establishment of incorrectness of an entry in the civil registration book
- 5 – establishment of the fact of birth registration
- 4 – establishment of the fact of kindred relations
- 7 – establishment of the fact of belonging of a document to smb.
- 1 – sanction for a coercive psychiatric examination

66 – institution of legal proceedings, including:

- 45 – pensions (recognition of the right to pension, recognition of the right to the recalculation of pension proceeding from the rate of wages, inclusion of records of service in the insurance period etc.)

1.3. Court cases pleaded by lawyers of our centers

The total number of legal proceedings instituted by lawyers of LCCs in the report period is 160. Results of their examination are as follows:
