The trip was successful in accomplishing our objectives, we made effective use of the time in country in order to accomplish the following:
- Productive discussions to understand the USG investments in HES with USAID and PEPFAR representatives from the Office of Population and Health, program management specialist (OVC), Youth Development Program, Education Development Office, Economic Growth, PEPFAR, Program Development Assistance and HIV-Free Generation Project.
- Hosted full day Household Economic Strengthening Workshop – Introduction to Key HES Concepts – on 1 March 2011, included 29 participants. The workshop received high evaluation marks, including a 4.9 out of 5 on “I will be able to use what I learned in this workshop”.
- Hosted full day Household Economic Strengthening Workshop – Draft Workplan presentations, Lessons Learned and Collaborative Opportunities– on 10 March 2011, included 26 participants. The workshop received high evaluation marks, including a 4.7 out of 5 on “I will be able to use what I learned in this workshop”. Full evaluations results are available upon request.
- Visited 5 APHIA Plus Programs (Western/Nyanza – Melanie Newman, RIFT Valley – John Fay, NAL Melanie Newman, Eastern – John Fay & Melanie Newman, Coast – John Fay and Melanie Newman) and AMPATH (John Fay), to provide targeted Technical Assistance on how to better target vulnerable populations in order to design, implement and maintain effective HES activities.
- Provided debrief session to USAID Kenya OPH team on approach taken, key findings from the field, resources provided, feedback from the IPs, and preliminary recommendations.
