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LEGAL BASE, TERMS AND OBJECTIVES

- The Energy Community Ministerial Council has jurisdiction to issue decisions to expand the Energy Treaty
- Decision made on December 18, 2007
- Deadline for implementation December 31, 2009
- Objective: Review, issuance and implementation of regulation with a view to:
 - Improve security of supply;
 - stimulate the electricity system development
 - Develop market



MAIN ELEMENTS OF THE DIRECTIVE

- Designation of competent bodies for security of supply;
- Issuing, implementation and acting according to issued operational rules;
- Provision of the balance between consumption and generation through:
 - Establishment of market;
 - Provision of reserve capacities;
 - Penetration of new generators through transparent processes;
 - Improvement of energy efficiency;
- Issuing of regulations that ensure adequate investments in the transmission and distribution network;
- Reporting;



IMPLEMENTATION ACTIVITIES (1)

- **Jurisdiction:** Analysis of regulations and amendments thereof, if applicable, for the purpose of determining the jurisdiction;
- **Operational safety:**
 - To ensure unhindered operation and development of transmission network;
 - Amendments to the Grid Code and Market Rules;
 - Drafting/amendments to and implementation of the rulebook for operational safety of the network;



IMPLEMENTATION ACTIVITIES (2)

- **Balancing of generation and consumption:**
 - Determine policy, design and establish wholesale market;
 - Develop the system based on economic criteria that will ensure adequate reserve capacities
 - Energy and regulatory policy, legislation and procedures to ease the building of new capacities



IMPLEMENTATION ACTIVITIES (3)

- Proper investments in transmission and distribution network:
 - Ensure realistic bases for the development of the Indicative plan for the development and building of transmission and distribution network;
 - Approval of the development plans through proper tariffs;
 - Development of the plan for building cross-border capacities
- Reporting:
 - Develop and harmonize the contents for mandatory reporting
 - Develop and harmonize the procedure for monitoring of the Directive implementation
