



ROTAVIRUS VACCINE

What you need to know

1. What is Rotavirus vaccine?

It is a vaccine that is effective at preventing diarrhoea and vomiting caused by rotavirus. Rotavirus vaccine is taken orally.

2. What does the Rotavirus vaccine do?

The Rotavirus vaccine protects *your* baby from diarrhoea.



3. When is the Rotavirus vaccine given?

Rotavirus vaccination is given to a baby at 6 weeks (one and a half months old) and 10 weeks (two and a half months old) after birth.

Visit your nearest health facility or outreach point to have your baby immunised.
