




- Providing veterinary and animal husbandry services to people at the village level:






## Provincial Peace Council/Committee and Joint Secretariat Team

The Afghanistan Peace and Reintegration Program (APRP) is led by the President of Afghanistan, who appointed a 70-person High Peace Council (HPC) to provide strategic direction to the program. An APRP Joint Secretariat (JS) executes the program for the HPC and is responsible for managing reintegration in the provinces.

The provincial governors (PGs) lead the peace process in the provinces. The PGs appoint a 25-30 person Provincial Peace Committee which is tasked with strategic and operational duties in support of APRP. They are supported by a five-person Provincial Joint Secretariat Team which is responsible for the technical execution of APRP in the province. Provincial Joint Secretariat Teams coordinate the peaceful reintegration of former insurgents into society. The Ghor Provincial Peace Committee was established on 4<sup>th</sup> of Hamal, 1390. Currently it has 24-24 committee members.

They are supported by a five-person Provincial Joint Secretariat Team which is responsible for the technical execution of APRP in the province. Provincial Joint Secretariat Teams coordinate the peaceful reintegration of former insurgents into society.

The Ghor Provincial Peace Committee was established on 4<sup>th</sup> of Hamal, 1390. Currently it has 24-24 committee members.


