



Steps to put on basic level personal protective equipment (PPE)


1 Place the impermeable gown over the scrubs.




2 Put on a face shield.



3 Perform hand hygiene.*



4 Put on gloves (over cuff).



While wearing PPE:

- Avoid touching or adjusting PPE
- Replace gloves if they become torn or damaged
- Change gloves between patients
- Perform hand hygiene before putting on new gloves
- Do not use your phone
- Change PPE after contact with body fluids

* Perform hand hygiene either with water and soap (40-60 sec) or using an alcohol-based handrub solution (20-30 sec) or >0.05% chlorine wash.

Steps to remove basic level PPE

1 Remove gown and gloves and roll inside-out and dispose of safely.



2 Perform hand hygiene.*



3 Remove face shield starting at the back of the head.



4 Perform hand hygiene.*



* Perform hand hygiene either with water and soap (40-60 sec) or using an alcohol-based handrub solution (20-30 sec) or >0.05% chlorine wash.
