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

1.0 Project Overview

STRIDES for Family Health is a five year project funded by USAID. The project aims to improve the quality of and access to integrated reproductive health (RH), family planning (FP) child survival (CS), Nutrition, Malaria prevention and treatment services to people who need them. The project contributes to the Uganda Government's efforts to improve the health of families and communities, fertility reduction, and lower the maternal, newborn, infant and child morbidity and mortality.

The specific goal of the project is to strengthen and support the health system across 15 collaborating districts and render it fully functional to deliver quality integrated RH, FP, CS, Nutrition and malaria prevention and treatment services to all who are in need of such services. In doing so, STRIDES strengthens, among other, service delivery points at every level, from community to district hospitals. The training of providers, managers, and leaders throughout the system is part of this process.

The STRIDES project is implemented by Management Sciences for Health (MSH) and its core partners - Communication for Development Foundation Uganda (CDFU), Jhpiego and Meridian International Group.

1.1 Project objectives

The STRIDES for Family Health objectives include:

- To increase the quality and provision of routine RH/FP, CS, Nutrition and Malaria prevention and treatment services in facilities and communities.
- To improve and expand access to and demand for RH/FP, CS, Nutrition and Malaria services at the community level.
- To advance use of RH/FP, CS, Nutrition and Malaria services through supportive systems.

1.2 Background to the strategy

While other African countries have seen major improvements, Uganda's total fertility rate (6.7), maternal mortality ratio (435/100,000) and under-five mortality rate (137/1000) have remained virtually the same for more than a decade. The reasons, among others, are related to a disproportionate focus on HIV/AIDS, Uganda's pro-natalist culture and possible failures of past programs in terms of long-term and sustainable impact.

As one of the strategies to address the above observed situation in Uganda, building capacity to deliver the integrated package of essential RH/FP, CS, Nutrition and Malaria services through training tailored to the needs of different levels of providers is a key intervention.

By working with strategically selected partners, the project aims to improve providers' knowledge, skills, performance and interactions with clients; and help reduce providers' biases. To this end the project aims at establishing a process for district-based, competency-based training and performance support.

This training strategy spells out the training approaches that are used by the project to strengthen and support provider performance to enhance the provision of RH/FP CS, Nutrition, Malaria services at the facility and community levels both in the public and private sectors.

1.3 Anticipated outcomes of the strategy

- Providers have up-to-date knowledge of and skills to deliver the full range of RH/FP, CS, Nutrition and Malaria services.
- Improved provider performance and provider-client interactions in relation to RH/FP CS, Nutrition and malaria services.
- Reduced provider bias against particular types of FP methods, clients and services.
- Increased demand / utilization of services as a result of improved community involvement by use of trained Village Health Teams.
- Increased Leadership and Management/Supervision skills at all levels.
- Improved data management.
- Integration of FP, HMIS. Immunization, Malaria, YPF SRH and nutrition in the various training areas.

2.0 Development/adoption of the training materials

The project will provide technical assistance to update/train providers in the following areas depending on districts needs:

- Basic Family Planning (BFP) Including Healthy Timing and Spacing of Pregnancy
- Long Acting FP (IUD and Implants) including Post Partum IUD Insertion
- Permanent FP Methods(Tubal ligation and Vasectomy) (doctor–nurse teams to be trained)
- Integrated Management of acute Malnutrition (IMAM)
- Essential Nutrition Actions(ENA)
- Infant and Young Child Feeding(IYCF)

- Baby Friendly Health facility Initiative (BFHI)
- Positive Deviance/Hearth (PD/H)
- Quality Improvement (QI)
- Malaria prevention and treatment services
- Basic Emergency Obstetric and Newborn care (BEmONC) including Active Management of Third stage of Labor and Helping Baby Breathe)
- Comprehensive Emergency Obstetric and Newborn Care(BEmONC)
- Integrated Management of Childhood and Newborn Illnesses (IMNCI)

The review process involves:

- In house review of materials by the technical review team where capacity is available. This team will include both U.S. - based technical experts (Jhpiego and MSH) as well as the STRIDES Uganda team.
- Hiring consultant(s) where project reviewers are not available.
- Identifying gaps and make the necessary recommendations based on the current national and international standards including WHO) recommendations.
- Convening stake holders meeting to agree and incorporate any suggested changes.
- Finalize content and formatting.
- Printing.

3.0 Selection of trainers and Preceptors

Trainers will be selected from national pools of trainers in the relevant field where these exist. Jhpiego- one of STRIDES partners will take lead in the training of TOTs for RH and FP. Trainers in the various skill areas will be identified through consultation with relevant MOH divisions and departments as well as collaborating districts. Similarly preceptors to support trainings at the practicum sites will be identified and trained on job in the relevant skill area. The identified trainers will be given a standardization course in the subject matter and a refresher course on effective facilitation and training skills. In addition, they will be trained /oriented as Trainers of trainers (TOT) in the following skill aspects:

- Training skills which includes :
 - Facilitation skills
 - Clinical training skills,
 - Mentoring and coaching.
- Documentation (e.g. success stories) and Report writing skills
- Supervision skills.

4.0 Selection and preparation of the practicum sites

Practicum sites for training in RH/FP, CS, Nutrition, and Malaria services will be identified in each district and prepared using up dated checklists. Regional sites will be identified to cater for trainings that may need to bring together participants from different districts in a given region. Regional training reduces the burden to districts of releasing many providers at one time for a particular training. Preceptors to support training in the practicum sites will be given on job training in the relevant skills.

5.0 Selection criteria for participants

The training for each district will be based on the district needs as reflected in the annual district work plan. STRIDES trains selected ***public and private providers*** in the various areas mentioned above.

STRIDES will provide a checklist (annex IV) to guide the districts in identifying and selecting suitable participants for the planned training. These will include:

- Ability to read and write and express oneself in the training language.
- Has demonstrated interest in the skill area.
- Is currently involved in activities of the skill.
- Basic qualification in the skill area is an added advantage.

5.1 Expected outcome of the training

Suitable participants attend the various training and apply the skills and knowledge acquired to improve the quality of RH/FP/CS/Nutrition and Malaria services from the training received, at their respective service delivery points.

Notes:

- a) Medical clinical officers to train in BEmONC (LSS/PAC) must have skills in bimanual palpation.
- b) Medical clinical officers and midwives can provide permanent FP methods only after specialized training and regular supervision.
- c) Medical Clinical officers and enrolled nurses need bimanual palpation/pelvic examination skills to perform IUD insertion.
- d) ML and vasectomy should aim at training doctor nurse teams at facilities with those cadres of staff.
- e) Registered nurse/midwives, enrolled Nurses/Midwives and enrolled registered comprehensive nurses can be trained as part of the nurse/midwife/doctor teams for the provision of permanent FP methods.
- f) CEmONC training to aim at training a team of three (medical officer, MW and anesthetic assistant)
- g) In all training, apart from VHTs (who may just need a refresher course if they had attended one recently), eligible participants should be those that have not undergone a similar training in the last three years.
- h) All cadres mentioned above can be trainers of the VHTs.
- i) PPIUD will target midwives and medical officers
- j) ETATp will be conducted only for H/C IV and Hospital level



Participants will be drawn from all facilities in the different districts. (See annex II)

6.0 Pre Training Tasks.

- The District Health officer, STRIDES district focal person, district trainer, or district health team selects participants for a given training following the specified guidelines for selection.
- Selected participants fill out bio data forms prior to coming for the training.
- STRIDES staff, trainers and the STRIDES district focal person verify the data in the bio data form at the district. The participant verification shall take a maximum of 5 days per district for all training areas as per district needs and the findings shall be documented and communicated to STRIDES and the DHOs.
- STRIDES staff visit the facilities where selected participants work to assess the work environment. This shall take a maximum of 3 days per district, and shall be conducted 2 weeks prior to the training. STRIDES staff, trainers discuss with the health unit in-charges, the STRIDES district focal person and District Health Officers the identified gaps and how best they can be addressed in order to enable the trained provider to implement the knowledge and skills acquired. This will be documented. For facilities where the environment is found not to be conducive for the participant to put to use what they would learn, plans will be prepared to make the environment suitable, possibly in collaboration with STRIDES.
 - For verification of trained providers, participants' passport photos are taken during training and these are stored in the STRIDES data base.
 - Willingness and commitment to learn and put in practice the knowledge and skills acquired from the training by the participant shall be verified during the visit at the facilities by the STRIDES staff and focal person.
 - The trainee carries his/her uniform for use during the practicum training.

7.0 Training approaches

A number of training methodologies will be used depending on the skill area. These will include:

- Regional/ District approach: This is where participants will be drawn from different regions/districts to make a class. This reduces on the number of people leaving their work site to go for a workshop at the same time.
- Group based: This is where the team/group of trainees is put together in a class room environment.
- On Job Training: Here trainer(s) goes to the trainee's work place for coaching and mentoring. This help to minimize on absenteeism as a result of attending workshops.
- During all training there will be an integrated module on IPC,QI and HMIS

8.0 Evaluation of the training

Various evaluation methods of the trainees will be used during the training. These include:

- Pre and post (mid-course) training evaluation for both knowledge and skills using standard evaluation tools.
- The post test will be conducted at the time in the course when all subject areas have been covered at the end of the training. A score of 85 % or more correct indicates knowledge-based mastery of the materials presented in the reference manual.
- End of each day evaluation, using: What went well today? What didn't go well? What should be done differently tomorrow? Etc.
- Using standard checklists to assess skills acquisition. Competency must first be achieved on models before practicing on clients.
- End of course evaluation to assess the level of satisfaction of the participants about the course.

9.0 Post-training tasks

- Trainees prepare application plans describing how the knowledge and skills acquired will be utilized back in the facility, including sharing the newly acquired knowledge and skills with colleagues.
- The follow up schedule: An integrated follow up schedule will be planned regionally where all trained providers are followed up at least quarterly and the visit will cover all skill areas.

Notes:

- Following the trend of integrated follow up, trainees will be followed up at least quarterly in all skill areas.
- For LDP, initial follow up is monthly for the first 3 months, thereafter any time between month 4 and 6, and then at 1 year.

10.0 Commitment by the district/STRIDES partnership

District commitment with STRIDES partnership will ensure:

- Availability of policy guidelines and service standards
- Drugs, contraceptives and supplies
- Availability of IEC materials and job aides
- A functional HMIS
- Strengthened referral system
- Regular facilitative supervision including quality improvement
- A functional community network
- Good leadership and support from facility managers

11.0 Certification:

Certification will be based on observed and measured performance using competency based (Knowledge, attitude and skill) assessments rather than on completion of the course. 85% and above is the recommended pass mark.

There will be continuous monitoring using scores attained at exit of training as well as performance at follow up using appropriate checklists. Providers performing according to standards will, then be given a certificate of competence.

ANNEXES:

I) Sample letter to DHO

An example of a letter to the District Health Officer requesting the selection of participants for the IUD training could read as follows:

The STRIDES for Family Health project is organizing an IUD training course. In order to be selected for the course participants should be medical officers, clinical officers, registered nurse/midwives, enrolled nurse/midwives, enrolled midwives or enrolled nurses and must have been recently trained in basic family planning. The participants should be currently working in one of the following services: Family Planning Clinics, Antenatal Clinic; Young Child Clinic (YCC); Female ward/ Gynecology ward; Adolescent friendly services; Maternity ward; and Outpatient Department in Health Center III and above.

It is expected that pre-selected candidates will fill a bio data form prior to the training, which will be verified by both the district and STRIDES technical team.

The candidate must be willing and committed to learn and put into practice the knowledge and skills acquired during the training. The candidate must also be willing to share the knowledge and skills acquired with her colleagues. Participants should carry their uniforms for use during practicum training.

The districts are also expected to provide a favorable working environment for the health providers to exercise their knowledge and skills. The minimum requirement includes the availability of: policy guidelines and service standards; IEC materials and job aides; commodities/drugs and functional equipment; a functional HMIS; adequate infrastructure providing privacy and confidentiality; a functional community network and referral system. The districts are also required to provide regular facilitative supervision including quality improvement and good leadership and support from facility managers.

These letters could be signed by regional coordinators.

ANNEX III

FFSDP Checklist

Background:

It is often hard to know why healthcare workers are not providing high-quality services. A site visit may identify performance gaps or problems and give one the information needed to determine what can be done to improve job performance.

The work site evaluator must understand the work environment to determine how far the training will close the performance gap.

- What is the health worker expected to do?
- “Under what conditions?”
- “With what frequency?”

In the evaluation, one should:

- Conduct a site visit before the training. Share information about the course with learners and their supervisors before the course begins
- Make sure that workers know what they are expected to do (have clear job expectations).
- Assess whether job expectations are realistic, given the current working environment
- Check that appropriate motivation and incentives for the learner are in place and that barriers to performance have been identified
- Determine whether interventions other than training are needed to improve job performance, and that the need for these interventions is taken into account to help ensure application of learning on the job.
