USAID/PHCPI 36 Model Clinics

Activities Supported by USAID/PHCPI

USAID/PHCPI is working with the MoH to refurbish 36 PHC centers with all of the required medical equipment and supplies necessary to effectively provide the services outlined in Iraq's Basic Health Services Package and to apply the newly acquired knowledge and skills obtained through USAID/PHCPI training and capacity building activities. PHCPI and the MoH's shared vision of a model clinic is a functional clinic equipped with modern medical devices, stocked with enough drugs and consumables, and efficiently functioning through reliable health systems and well trained staff, practicing clinical protocols and guidelines to ensure the application of best practices. It is the goal of the model clinic activities to achieve the maximum impact of the technical competence of the service providers and the optimal physical environment, collectively contributing to enhancement of quality PHC services. It is the intention of the Government of Iraq (GoI) to upgrade the balance of the 360 clinics to meet this model standard. PHCPI selected two model clinics in each of the 18 provinces

For the purpose of providing technical and capacity building training, refurbishing and rehabilitating the selected 36 PHCCs, PHCPI created a team of 18 model clinic coordinators to oversee the project implementation activities at the clinic level. The coordinators, in close collaboration with MoH, identified a set of standards and criteria that are necessary for the model clinics optimal functioning and day to day operations which all model clinics should have.

In July 2013, USAID/PHCPI conducted a rapid assessment for the model clinics to identify the gaps and the specific needs for each clinic. Several aspects were measured in the assessment including the: 1) physical structure, utilities and furniture; 2) Cleanliness and infection control; 3) Patients' rights and client care; 4) Diagnostic and pharmaceutical services; 5) Health Promotion and Community partnership; 6) leadership, management and quality improvement; 7) medical records and continuity of care; and 8) mother and child health.

In August and early September 2013, PHCPI has delivered and distributed all the required equipment to the 36 model clinics among all the provinces. It's worth mentioning that there were a missing in some of the items in the provinces of Erbil and Kirkuk but the provider will complete these items by mid of September. The installation of the equipment and training will take place by mid-September
