Executive Summary

Increasingly both the international community and Afghan government understand that the inability or unwillingness to deliver basic services to the Afghan population, most of all governance, justice and security, has led to a decrease in popular support for the current Afghan administration. Resource-based conflicts, mostly regarding land, have posed particular problems, as the limited capacity of the government to solve them has in some cases created conditions that give rise to broader conflict and violence. As a result communities increasingly feel alienated from the Afghan state, a situation the Taliban and other insurgent groups have been able to exploit. Traditional community-based dispute resolution (CBDR) is one of the most prominent avenues to improve this situation, especially if CBDR can develop standards to ensure a degree of justice and equity for all parties, and find ways to link to the Afghan state.

Thus to improve dispute resolution services, increase dispute resolution capacity, and reduce the destabilising potential of unresolved conflicts, The Liaison Office (TLO), in conjunction with TetraTech/ARD, facilitated, between April and July 2012, three Forums to discuss several matters relating to the relationship of CBDR to Afghan law, and to develop and approve Guidelines related to the resolution of land disputes, suitable for use throughout Nangarhar province, as well as a Para-legal land document. In all cases, Forum participants either developed content for the documents themselves, or explicitly approved both their form and content.

With final approval of Forum participants in hand, TLO arranged for the Guidelines' compilation into book form, and reproduction. Once TetraTech and TLO had finalized the physical aspects of the Guidelines, they arranged for a final, "Dissemination" meeting.

This meeting encompassed a presentation (or re-presentation) of the content, both written and graphic, of the Guidelines and Para-legal document, by TLO and TetraTech. Following, several of those assembled, both men's and women's representatives, endorsed the Guidelines – calling for their wide dissemination throughout Jalalabad and promotion through the media. Finally, TLO distributed 48 copies of the Guidelines to those assembled, with plans to distribute the remaining 452 copies in the coming weeks.

1 Summary of Meeting Objectives

The January 17, 2013 CBDR Guidelines Dissemination Meeting encompassed two objectives:

- First, final presentation of the completed Guidelines to attendees; and
- Second, completing first-round dissemination to attendees.

2 Meeting Agenda

3 Meeting Attendance

Overall, 47 people attended the CBDR Guidelines Dissemination Meeting (see Table 1 below). These included 16 female participants, and 31 male participants.

Female participants included two professors of Nangarhar University (Mrs. Masuma and Mrs. Sheela Babori), and three members of the Nangarhar Provincial Council (Mrs. Angiza, Mrs. Muhtarama, and Mrs. Zahra). In turn, male participants included tribal elders, religious leaders, and government representatives such as the Director of the Jalalabad City Municipality (Eng. Hahimudin), Head of the Public Rights Division of the Appeals Court (Qazi Muhammad Mossa), and the Director of the Estates Department Archive (Eng. Shihzad).

Below is presented a complete guest list for the meeting. Female participants are listed prior to male participants, with the exception of Mrs. Zarsanga Shoma, a last-minute addition. Those persons whom TLO and TetraTech invited, but who could not attend, are marked in gray. Finally, a reproduction of the meeting's Attendance Sheet may be found in Appendix I of this report.

4 Record of Meeting Activities

TLO and TetraTech conducted the CBDR Guidelines Dissemination meeting at the Spinghar Hotel in Jalalabad.

After registration, the meeting began with the project’s Focal Point/Field Manager, Qazi Sharifullah Amin, welcoming all participants. He then went over the day’s course of events, roughly encompassing an explanation (or reiteration) of the Guidelines’ content and process of development; remarks by TetraTech/ARD; and endorsements of the Guidelines by a variety of distinguished persons in assembly.

- CBDR Project Manager Mr. Asif Karimi introduced the Guidelines and Para legal document to meeting participants. After refreshing the memory of those assembled on the process of Guidelines development, he walked them through Guidelines’ content, both written and illustrated (those assembled already having approved Guidelines’ written content and illustrations).
- Following Mr. Karimi, Mr. Wali Kandiwal, of TetraTech/ARD, reiterated that the Guidelines are a very important document for the people of Ningarhar province. He furthermore added that, in the future, TetraTech/ARD will provide training for *jirgamaran* (“jirga members”) and other community leaders on the Guidelines. Mr. Kandiwal also left open the possibilities of the

Guidelines undergoing further revisions, if community members found such revisions pressing.

- Once Mr. Kandiwal had concluded, several of those assembled (not initially scheduled to speak), came forward and offered their endorsement of the Guidelines. Qazi Mossa, Head of the Public Rights Division at the Nangarhar Appeals Court, stated his happiness with the

Guidelines and Para-legal Document, and opined them very helpful for the people of Nangarhar. He also added that it is a “good tool” according to both traditional (community-based) and Sharia dispute resolution systems. Finally, Qazi Mossa added that training in the Guidelines will be highly beneficial for those regularly involved in the resolution of disputes.

- After Qazi Mossa, Mohammad Arif, of Nangarhar University, endorsed the Guidelines, requesting that it be shared with elders in districts throughout Nangarhar. He added that the people would understand it, making it particularly helpful for those actively resolving disputes, and that the Guidelines should be promoted through the media.
- Mrs. Muhtarama, of Nangarhar’s Provincial Council, stated her happiness with the Guidelines, emphasizing the active participation of those assembled in Guidelines’ development over three previous meetings. She added that the Guidelines should be promoted in the media, and that, in subsequent trainings on the Guidelines, women should be included.
- Mawlawi Habibullah mentioned that general awareness of the Guidelines and Para-legal land document is necessary. He also emphasized the development of these documents by all the people assembled, especially bringing agreement on the form and content of customary documentation.
- Haji Nur Agha said that the program should be extended to the districts, training should be conducted, and general awareness of the Guidelines and Para-legal document should be spread.

After these remarks, TLO distributed copies of the CBDR Guidelines and Para-legal document to those assembled. The next section of this report gives an account of the recipients of said Guidelines.

5 Document Distribution

Those persons who received the CBDR Guidelines and copies of the Para-legal document at the meeting overlap almost entirely with those persons who attended the meeting. However, several differences should be noted. First, one individual, Mr. Zarsanga Soma, did not receive a copy of the documents. Second, two persons working with TLO on this project also took copies of the Guidelines (during project hiatus they took other employment). These were Ms. Adiba, currently an employee of the Human Rights Commission in Jalalabad, and Ms. Nazia, currently working with the non-governmental organization International Relief and Development.

A list of those persons receiving copies of the Guidelines and Para-legal document may be found below at Table 2. Those people on the distribution list, but unable to be present, are marked in gray. In turn, those persons who received the documents, but who were not attendees for the general meeting, are marked in orange. Finally, a reproduction of the original Guidelines Distribution List may be found in Appendix II of the present report.











Image 2: CBDR Guidelines Distribution


