Does the HC use the sexes disaggregate data collected for decision making and improving your services?			
Sex disaggregated data collected on attendants of various trainings on nutrition matter			
Is there routine assessment carried to <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Identify barriers to access to agricultural /extension services by men and women?</li> <li>• To identify practices and taboos related to caring and feeding of pregnant and lactating woman and children</li> </ul>			
Do the HCs involve male and female staff in the routine monitoring activities of the health services?			
<b>Livelihood and ES ( vulnerable households)</b>			
Sex and age disaggregated data collected on members of targeted household			

Were men and women/ girls and boys in the households receive prior consultation/orientation on the supports provided to the HHs			
Does the project collect gender disaggregated data is collected for VHHs supported through ENGINE intervention			
Does the project increases/improve women's access to and control over nutrition resources in the HHs?			
Do you involve men in the households in the need assessment and target setting during the selection of the HHs?			
Do you have criteria for deciding the proportion male and female headed households in a given kebele/site?			
Is there a routine monitoring on the situation of female headed households who have been provided with livelihood and ES supports <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• regarding work load and labor demand</li> <li>• handling animals and caring for them</li> </ul>			
Do men and women in the HHs received training on skills related to livelihood ( livestock husbandry , home gardening, entrepreneurship, saving, gender, nutrition etc)			
<b>Farmers training center ( FTC)</b>			
Sex disaggregated data on farmers attending agronomic practice/demonstration			
Sex disaggregated data on farmers who are supported / provided with improved seeds for home gardening			
Do you regularly monitor the participation of men and women in the activities of the FTCs?			
The agriculture workers provide education and information for men and women

Do you train men and women teachers on gardening to support the school vegetable gardening activities

Do you engage male and female students in school gardening activities?			
Do you teach male and female students on nutrition and gender? What are the entry points you use to pass these messages?			
Do you invite and provide nutrition and gender messages for parents (male and female) using different events?			
<b>Women group</b>			
Do you involve male and female community members, religious leaders, grass root women organizations, government partners etc in the selection of the members of the women group?			
Do you involve the above mentioned parties in the monitoring of the activities of the women group?			
Does the project set mechanisms to routinely monitor the status and activities of the project? If yes, how are you doing that?			
Do the women groups have regular meeting to discuss on nutrition and other related matters?			
Does the project support the women groups to			

establish functional saving groups and monitor their success?			
Does the project support the women group to link them to the important services they require to operate			
<b>Partnership</b>			
Do you carry out meeting and communication with women/youth and children affairs /bureaus and women associations/ organizations at grass root level? What are the issues and gender concerns raised on such meetings?			
Do you have recorded collaboration with other partners and organizations operating in the same area? What are the areas for collaboration			
<b>Monitoring and supervision</b>			
Do you involve men and women in your monitoring team			
Do you conduct supportive supervision conducted involving women's organizations at grass root level? At what interval?
