

DO YOU THINK JUSTICE WAS NOT MADE FOR YOU?



You have the right to file an appeal against the court decision.

The time period for filing an appeal against a court decision is:

*30 days from the issue of the decision for civil actions (*Civil Procedure Code, Article 362*)

*15 days from the issue of the decision for criminal actions (*Criminal Procedure Code, Article 402*)

*If the time period for an appeal expires and the appeal has not been filed,
the court decision becomes final and enforceable.*
