A candidate with a degree in Architecture and senior level experience in Construction Management would also be considered. Professional Engineer registration or Architectural Registration is required. The candidate should have a minimum of 15-18 years experience with a minimum of 5 years recent experience in the construction management of building structures. The candidate should have first hand knowledge of building materials including masonry construction, concrete framing, and concrete foundations. Good written communication skills are a must. Overseas experience, although not required, would be a plus. Candidate must be able to obtain Secret Security Clearance and must be US Citizen.
