Mission Ready is an interactive security training platform designed for aid workers in the field. It uses cutting-edge technology to enhance learning through real-time, ‘point-of-view’ video scenarios, putting aid workers in the kind of situations they are likely to face in the field. This innovation in training results in an immersive and engaging learning experience.

Mission Ready is the product of a close collaboration between disaster relief NGO RedR UK and Digital Training Solutions (DTS) and is guided by security experts from 13 leading NGOs, humanitarian forums and security platforms. Mission Ready also worked with award-winning filmmakers to make the learning experience as realistic as possible.

The first course, **Field Security Management**, was launched in October 2015 and since then has been acquired by over 700 aid workers in 40 different countries. The aim of this course is to equip all members of staff, regardless of location, with the practical tools and knowledge they need to keep themselves and their team safe whilst working in a hostile environment.

After the success of Field Security Management, Mission Ready has now launched its second course, **Remote Security Management**. It is aimed at bridging the gap between HQ, regional and field staff communications on remote security challenges, decisions and practical actions throughout the project life cycle. Set in a fictional Middle Eastern country, this course draws on the current humanitarian challenges that the region is facing. Currently this course is only available in English, it will be translated into Arabic as a priority.


Both courses comprise of a mix of written, audio and visual content in addition to the assessed interactive video scenarios.

Accessibility

Mission Ready is designed to be as accessible as possible, to ensure staff in hard-to-reach field locations get the same access to quality training. With this in mind the platform is available in both high & low bandwidth options and as a downloadable desktop app, which mitigates any issues with poor internet connections.



As well as this, the first course is available in English/ French/ Arabic/ Spanish, and licences start at just \$8 (for both courses). The fees sit within a banded fee structure, allowing smaller NGOs to access the tool at much lower rates. This, along with the e-learning nature of the tool, ensures Mission Ready is able to train aid workers all over the world. For full details please see our website: www.missionready.org.uk



Course Content

The Mission Ready platform is made up of both concise and accessible written content as well as visual and interactive video content.

In addition to this, information and tips are provided throughout both courses from leading security experts in the sector. Also to make the content as beneficial as possible in Remote Security Management, the interests and challenges for different members of a remote team are highlighted (frontline staff/ regional staff/ HQ).

At the end of each module, interactive scenarios will test the learner's ability to apply their knowledge from the course content. Essential theory will be immediately be put into practice in real-life simulation exercises, after which step-by-step feedback is given.
