



Total ODA Disbursements 2010-2012 (USD millions):





ORGANIZATIONAL OVERVIEW & LEADERSHIP



- ◆ Denmark's Official Development Assistance (ODA) is implemented by Danida, in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
- ◆ Mogens Jensen was appointed Minister for Trade and Development Cooperation on February 3, when the position of Minister for Development was merged with that of Trade.
- ◆ In 2012, Denmark provided \$2.7 billion in ODA. Approximately \$2 billion (72 percent) was implemented bilaterally versus \$761 million (28 percent) implemented multilaterally.

POLITICAL CONTEXT AND FUNDING TRENDS

- ◆ Denmark is one of only five countries in the world that achieve the UN target of granting 0.7 percent of gross national income (GNI) in development assistance. In 2012 it contributed 0.83 percent GNI.
- ◆ One of Denmark's top priorities for 2014 is green growth. In this sector they are global leaders, hosting an annual Green Growth Forum and supporting innovative sustainable energy projects in Africa.
- ◆ Denmark recently gave up its co-chairmanship on the International Dialogue for Peacebuilding and Statebuilding, but continues to remain a champion of global resilience, in part by co-leading the New Deal processes in South Sudan.

DEVELOPMENT PRIORITIES

- ◆ In 2012, Denmark's top three aid recipients were Tanzania (\$119m), Mozambique (\$98m) and Afghanistan (\$87m).
- ◆ Sub-Saharan Africa accounted for 41 percent (\$830m) of Denmark's total ODA disbursements in 2012.
- ◆ In 2012, Denmark spent 22 percent (\$306m) of Sector Allocable ODA on Government & Civil Society Programs.






By Income Group (USD m)
