


DONOR SNAPSHOT: UNITED KINGDOM

Total ODA (USD millions):





ORGANIZATIONAL OVERVIEW & LEADERSHIP

- ◆ UK Official Development Assistance (ODA) is implemented by the UK Department for International Development (DFID). Justine Greening, UK Secretary of State for International Development, was appointed head of DFID in September 2012.
- ◆ In 2012, the UK provided \$13.9 billion in ODA. Approximately \$8.7 billion, or 63%, of UK ODA was implemented bilaterally, with \$5.2 billion, or 37%, implemented multilaterally.
- ◆ UK law stipulates that poverty reduction is the purpose of development assistance.

POLITICAL CONTEXT AND FUNDING TRENDS

- ◆ In 2014, the UK will maintain its level of ODA at 0.7% of gross national income (GNI). The UK first achieved the goal of reaching 0.7% ODA/GNI in 2012 and remain committed to the standard, although efforts to enshrine the standard in UK law have faltered.
- ◆ The next UK general election will take place on May 7, 2015. Any collaboration with the UK on which we desire political attention should take place prior to September. After which, it is unlikely that international development will receive significant political attention in the UK as most of the Government gears up for the election.

DEVELOPMENT PRIORITIES

- ◆ Gender equality and women's empowerment will be high on the agenda for DFID in 2014. In July, Prime Minister Cameron will host a high-level summit on ending forced marriage and GBV.
- ◆ Humanitarian assistance is a core priority for DFID. They are a leader, along with USAID, in the response to the crisis in Syria, and respond strongly, with resources and political attention, to all natural and man-made disasters.
- ◆ Economic development continues to be a priority for DFID, including a strong focus on employment and private sector development.
- ◆ The GAVI replenishment is also a topline political priority.

OTHER RELEVANT INFORMATION

- ◆ Secretary Greening is one of the three Co-Chairs of the Global Partnership for Effective Development Cooperation (GPEDC) but will give up that position following the First High-Level Meeting of the GPEDC in Mexico City, April 15-16, 2014.






By Income Group (USD m)
