


Food Assistance to Syrian Refugees

Armed violence and conflict in Syria has escalated over the past year, increasing the number of refugees to more than **4.5 million** in the neighboring countries of Lebanon, Turkey, Jordan, Iraq, and Egypt and resulting in **6.5 million** internal displaced persons. In response to the crisis, which has left millions food insecure, USAID’s Office of Food for Peace (USAID/FFP) and its partners have provided food vouchers for over 1.3 million Syrians in neighboring countries, enabling them to buy food in local markets. In Fiscal Year 2015, USAID/FFP provided more than **\$244 million to the UN World Food Program (WFP)** to assist Syrian refugees in meeting these urgent food needs.
