I. INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this project is to assist the Government of Guyana in the Diversification and Development of its Agriculture. This agreement provides funds for an in-country training course in Project Development and Analysis for 20 key Government personnel working in the area of Agriculture.

II. BACKGROUND

Traditionally, Guyana's major agricultural activities have centered around sugar cane and rice. In recent years the GOG has realized the necessity to diversify its agriculture to include increased food and feed crops and livestock production. A contract was negotiated with the University of Florida to provide assistance to Government in its efforts to diversify its agricultural base, specifically to assist the Government in the research needed to develop the country's production of legumes, oil crops and grasses (peanuts, sorghum, soybeans, cassava and forages), selected vegetables (tomatoes, onions, cabbage and carrots), and of beef. In accordance with these objectives the Contract also provides for assistance in the development of an indigenous research and extension capability. These are in accordance with the specific overall project purpose which is to develop for planning purposes, economically viable agricultural planning systems for the intermediate savannahs, and the coastal and riverine areas of the country.


III. NATURE AND SCOPE OF WORK

A. University of Florida

The University of Florida, under the USAID financed contract with the Guyana Government, will continue to provide the long and short term technical assistance, commodities and participant training under the various task orders to reach objectives outlined above.

B. Participants

In addition to the operational training to be provided under the University of Florida Contract, participating training will be provided in other areas of Agriculture under General Training Project # 030, in accordance with the goals of this project, subject to USAID review and within the funds available.

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IV. FUNDING REQUIREMENTS

A. U.S. CONTRIBUTION

USAID will initially provide \$6,000 for financing the Project Development and Analysis Course proposed to be held in Guyana in early October. Funding for the University of Florida Contract will be provided at a later date.

B. GOVERNMENT OF GUYANA CONTRIBUTION

It is anticipated that the Government of Guyana will continue its contribution at or above the present Ministry of Agriculture capital expenditures budget of G\$ 640,000 (\$320,000 U.S. Dollar equivalent).

V. FINANCIAL PROVISIONS

A. Method of Payment

USAID will pay the costs of Contracts associated with this agreement directly to the contractor upon submission of required documentation (standard U.S. Voucher Form) provided such documentation is accompanied by a certificate of satisfactory performance issued by the Ministry of Agriculture and AID Form 281 "Invoice and Contract Abstract".

VI. OTHER PROVISIONS

It is understood that all technical service contracts funded under this Agreement must be approved by USAID/GUYANA as being within applicable AID regulations.
