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3. Original or
Revision No. 1I. INTRODUCTION

In support of the Government of Guyana's effort to diversify and develop its agriculture, this project is designed to promote soybean research, production, processing and utilization.

This Agreement provides funds for the services of U.S. consultants and the procurement of certain commodities not available in Guyana.

It is expected that any U.S. training component of this project can be funded from the Human Resources Development Loan now being negotiated.

II. BACKGROUND

Sugar cane and rice are the major crops in Guyana but in order to increase farm income and productivity there is a need to diversify and intensify the use of labor and water resources. In addition to the more intensive use of the coastal region there is an urgent need to develop the agricultural technology that will make it possible to develop selected areas in the interior. From the limited experience gained thus far, soybeans seem to be an excellent crop possibility for the interior as well as the coastal region.

III. NATURE AND SCOPE OF WORK

University of Illinois. The University of Illinois, under a USAID-financed contract will provide technical assistance and commodities in support of Guyana's soybean improvement program. Consultants will include crop improvement specialists, an agricultural economist, processing, utilization, and seed improvement specialists, food technologist and a microbiologist. It is expected that these consultants will spend a total of approximately ten (10) man-months in Guyana during the life of project.

IV. FUNDING REQUIREMENTS

A. U.S. Contribution: USAID will provide \$41,775 to finance salaries, per diem, international travel, commodities and administrative overhead; under "Other Costs" funds will be provided for in-country secretarial services, and air and overland transportation for the University of Illinois, plus normal project recurring costs. A detailed budget is attached as Appendix A.
