The Minister is aware of organizational and budget requirements. Without committing himself to what the final decisions might be, he indicated re-organization and budgets were being planned in accordance with the CENTA loan. He indicated that the lack of coordination in various MAG agencies was his major concern and he was seeking to reduce or eliminate the problem.

Since the budget cycle is just beginning, the Subsecretary is seeking to meet both staffing and budget requirements for the CY-76 and is aware of the implications of the problems for CY-77.

Mission will continue evaluations and monitoring activities. No other Mission action is required at this time.
