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I. OBJECTIVES

The purpose of this project is to assist the Government of Uganda in building and expanding a strong independent cooperative movement by:

- A. Improving management skills, at all levels from the primary society to the Central Union, in the marketing of crops and animal products.
- B. Assisting the new societies and unions working with new and diversified crops in the proper use of credit and marketing facilities.
- C. Assisting the Cooperative Alliance, the training arm of the cooperative movement, to become self-sustaining through contributions from member societies and District Unions, and to educate its members and committeemen.
- D. Supporting the Agriculture and Cooperative Departments in their efforts to build an interlocking short, medium, and long term supervised credit program. This involves training 300 Agricultural and Cooperative Assistants in farm planning and credit supervision to operate the Agricultural Credit Advisory Service (ACAS).
- E. Helping the Cooperative Department to expand the rural Thrift society scheme to 150 member societies by the end of FY 1973, in order to generate capital for loans and development purposes through an Agriculture or Cooperative Bank.
- F. Assisting in the expansion of credit societies to approximately 600 by the end of FY 1973.
- G. Establishing Cooperative Savings and Credit programs for: 1) Uganda's 2200 farmer marketing societies, 2) urban wage earners societies. A School Savings Scheme to instill the thrift habit with students will be demonstrated in nineteen school districts.

II. FINANCING

This Project Agreement obligates funds to finance through June 30, 1973, technical assistance for the Department of Cooperatives under a contract with Agriculture Cooperative Development International (ACDI) to provide commodities required in support of technicians and to meet other local costs.
