

IV. PROGRESS TO DATE

Continuing assistance has been provided to the Ministry of Public Health in its program of decentralized generalized health services. The Chief Public Health Division continues to serve on many key Ministry committees involved directly or indirectly with this program and also attends numerous conferences, seminars, etc., practically all of which relate to further development of the rural health service infrastructure. The recent Gondar graduates have been assigned to establish Provincial Health Departments, 61 service health centers and, for supervision purposes, to 8 training health centers, to augment and complete staffing requirements.

Eight candidates were selected and sent for training during FY 1969. During the same period 12 participants completed training and returned for assignment to health projects. During FY 1970, eight participants are to be sent for training and 10 are expected to return for assignment.

Establishment of the Department of Health Education and Training as an integral service of the Ministry of Public Health is completed. The Department now includes a professional staff of 3 health education specialists at the central office with supporting services and auxiliary personnel, e.g. projectionist, artist, script writer, library, film loan service, etc. Offset printing, silk-screen supplies, photograph laboratory are available for operation. The major problem of technical personnel for the Materials Projection Section is still to be resolved.

Increased staff has returned to support the Nursing Division's program of supervision and guidance to nurse training facilities and hospital and public health nursing services.

Regulations for Midwifery, Nursing, and Dresser Education have been revised and up-graded. Dresser Education Regulation revisions have been pointed toward preparing auxiliary health workers capable of better supporting rural public health services and specific programs such as Malaria Eradication, as well as hospital nursing service. Improved regulations for National Certification to practice nursing have been established.

Recruitment activities for all levels of nursing personnel have been strengthened and a standard pre-entrance nursing examination, structured with the assistance of Ministry of Education Tests and Measurements experts (including USAID-provided personnel) has been introduced in all schools of nursing.

During 1968-69, the national graduate nurse strength increased to 700, certified trained dressers to 3,350. During the same period, six schools of nursing had a student enrollment of 375 at various stages of training. A total of 23 Ministry of Public Health approved dresser training programs have been established. Student enrollment during 1968-69 was 400. Peace Corps Volunteer nurses are giving assistance in 7 of the government-sponsored dresser programs.

Expansion of the existing three government Schools of Nursing and the establishment of the new Duke of Harrar School of Nursing, in keeping with the Third Five-Year Plan, has been planned to realize a student nurse enrollment of 400 by 1970, and the annual addition of 90 graduate nurses to the health services.

Returned USAID participants have been assigned to support and strengthen government schools of nursing as well as the nursing service administration in teaching hospitals.

V. FINANCIAL PLAN

By the terms of the Agreement, the U.S. agrees to contribute up to \$145,500 and the IEG agrees to contribute the equivalent of \$7,575 (Eth.\$178,900) to the project in FY 1970. The U.S. contribution represents both the amounts fiscally obligated by this document as shown on the face sheet (and below) and the anticipated costs for technician services as shown below.






