Problem: Your authorization is required to extend, without additional funding, the 211(d) grant on "Tropical Soils", AID/csd-2834 with Cornell University. The requested extension period is 8 months. This extension will provide the additional time required to complete work on the soils component of this grant as currently specified.

Discussion: A two year funded grant to Cornell University for soils and biological nitrogen fixation (BNF) areas was approved and implemented on June 30, 1976. Later a six month extension until December 31, 1978 was given to cover work slippage in the early start-up period of the grant. The grant was extended for another month, until January 31, 1979 to determine the disposition of BNF component of the grant. A new grant in the BNF area has now been approved instead of extending the ongoing grant. This leaves no mechanism to complete the printing and distribution of two publications of the soils component. (a proceedings of a workshop held, December 11-15, 1978 and a guideline, both on soil resource inventory). The University has approximately \$12,500 remaining in grant funds to cover the cost of editing, printing and distribution of approximately 1,500 copies each of the two publications. These publications will be highly useful to LDCs. Cornell has requested an unfunded extension through September 30, 1979 to complete this work in a satisfactory manner. (see attached letter of request)

Recommendation: That you sign the enclosed PAF to authorize the unfunded extension through September 30, 1979 of the 211(d) grant with Cornell University.

Following your telephone call of today related to the termination of 211(d) grant CSD 2834, I am informing you that the publication of the research results will need an extension without funding until September 30, 1979.

The extension is needed for the completion of the original scope of work, with no additional new undertakings that had not been foreseen in the workplan.

The publication of the following documents is at stake:


- (1) Proceedings of a workshop, held 11-15 December 1978, on "Soil Resource Inventories and Development Planning." The manuscripts are now being reviewed, need editing, typing and printing, and to be distributed. We estimate about 350 pages.
- (2) "Guidelines for Soil Resource Inventories Characterization," manuscript which has been reviewed, needs to be redrafted, edited, printed and distributed. It amounts to about 250 pages.
- (3) Preparation of a final report of the grant period.

An estimate of the required budget, for which funds are available on the balance of our present grant account, is attached to this letter.

I would appreciate a final decision as soon as possible.
