

Re: AID Loan 383-T-021 : Paddy Storage
& Processing - Implementation Letter No. 3

With reference to Paddy Marketing Board letter Number VM/10/7/6-116 dated June 15, 1979, USAID has reviewed and approves the IFB No. 02105 which provides for the procurement of certain equipment for the Government of Sri Lanka, Paddy Marketing Board, 101/1 Sir Chittampalam Gardiner Mawatha, Colombo 2.

However, pursuant to discussions held on June 15, 1979 between representatives of the PMB and the USAID it was agreed that the earliest date by which the IFB could be issued would be July 9, 1979 and would be done so simultaneously in Colombo, Sri Lanka and in Washington D.C. at the Government of Sri Lanka Embassy.

It is the responsibility of the Government of Sri Lanka to produce and distribute sufficient numbers of copies of the IFB for issuance in Colombo and 50 copies to the Embassy of Sri Lanka, Washington D.C.

The USAID is arranging for the publication of the IFB 02105 in the Commerce Business Daily.

After the date of issue of the IFB 02105 on July 9, 1979 the USAID considers a period of 45 days to be a reasonable period for world-wide bidders to respond to the IFB.

This tendering period terminates at 14.30 hours August 23, at which time, hour and place the Government of Sri Lanka will open all of the tenders.
