AMENDMENT NO. 1  
TO  
PROJECT AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN  
THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF BANGLADESH  
AND  
THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA  
FOR  
RURAL ELECTRIFICATION PROJECT

Dated: February 15, 1979

Amendment No. 1 dated February 15, \_\_\_\_\_, 1979 between The People's Republic of Bangladesh ("Government") and the United States of America acting through the Agency for International Development ("AID").

WHEREAS, the Government and AID entered into a Project Agreement No. 388-0021 dated December 15, 1977 and

WHEREAS AID has agreed to Grant the Government additional funds for the Project; and to amend certain provisions of said Project Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, The Government and AID agree to amend Project Agreement No. 388-0021 as follows:

1. ARTICLE 3. Financing. Section 3.2. The Grant.

SECTION 3.2. The Grant. Delete the last line beginning with "twenty one" and insert the following "thirty four million United States (U. S. ) dollars (\$34, 000, 000) ("Grant").

2. ARTICLE 5: Conditions Precedent to Disbursement.

A. SECTION 5.3. Disbursements From Incremental Funds.

Delete Section 5.3(b) in its entirety and insert therefor the following:

"(b) Establishment of guidelines for approval and review of rural electric societies rate structures. These guidelines should reflect the principle that all rural electric societies are intended to become self

financing by a specific future date, while at the same time providing service at charges, to the extent possible to permit at least 75 percent of the potential domestic users in each rural electric society area to participate."

F. SECTION 5.3(e). Delete Section 5.3(e) in its entirety and reletter Section 5.3(f) as Section 5.3(e).

3. ARTICLE 6: Special Covenants.

SECTION 6.3. Consumer Rates. Delete in its entirety and insert therefor the following:

"SECTION 6.3. Consumer Rates. The rate guidelines called for in Section 5.3(b) above will be adjusted as necessary to ensure adequate progress in attaining financial self sufficiency while at the same time maintaining charges for domestic service at levels which permit at least 75 percent of the potential domestic users in each rural electric society area to participate."

4. ARTICLE 8. Disbursements.

SECTION 8.1. Disbursements for Foreign Exchange Costs.

Remove the period at the end of Section 8.1(a) (2) and add the following clause: "or (b) directly to one or more contractors or suppliers, committing AID to pay such contractors or suppliers for such goods or services."


5. All other terms and conditions of the Project Agreement No. 388-0021 dated December 15, 1977 shall remain in full force and effect.
