Thank you for agreeing to be a member of the Steering Group for the subject project. Attached for your information is a copy of the approved PP and a memo to TA/FPU clarifying implementation procedures for the project.

As the funds for the first Grant are in FY76 we need to move quickly. I would, therefore, ask you to review the memo on implementation procedures and suggest any changes and/or additions you feel necessary.

The Asia Bureau has suggested a country and an institution for the first grant. If the Mission concurs, I will go to Pakistan in May to discuss the possible activity with the Institute of Educational Research in Lahore. Upon return and before writing the PIO/T I will ask the Steering Group to review the activity. I would be happy to have the group meet before the proposed trip to Pakistan if any member(s) feel it is necessary.

The attached PP, LDC Institutional Involvement in Nonformal Education Programs, was cleared by R & DC on March 2, 1976, on the condition that procedures and criteria to be used in project implementation and evaluation be clarified to remove reservations expressed by LA/DR/EST. A memo of clarification was cleared by LA/DR/EST on April 2 and is attached as part of this PP (Annex B).

TA/EHR anticipates receiving a cable within the next few days from USAID Pakistan advising that a ProAg for the first grant (\$90,000) can be executed prior to 30 June 1976.
