ACTION MEMORANDUM FOR THE DEPUTY ASSISTANT ADMINISTRATOR, DSB

Problem: To obtain your approval for a one-year extension with additional funds for "Social Science Research on the Determinants and Consequences of Fertility," (Project No. 932-0616).

Background: The project paper authorizing AID to fund research studies on the determinants of fertility was signed in June, 1976. Since that time, a number of small research projects has been funded, either through the recommendation of USAID Missions or through two research competitions. One of the latter was held in summer 1977 on the socio-economic correlates to fertility, including especially the role and status of women. The other was held in summer 1978 on the interrelations between health, particularly that of mothers and infants, and fertility.

A total of \$2,510,000 was obligated under this project through FY 1978 in support of 18 research studies out of a total approved amount of \$3,000,000.

Discussion: Several actions are pending which we were unable to complete last year prior to the close of the fiscal year. We have now received Asia Bureau clearance for the substitution of Sri Lanka for Iran in the University of North Carolina proposal for the study of "Interrelationships Between Infant Mortality and Fertility in Jordan and Iran," using World Fertility Survey data (WFS). It will require an additional \$40,000. We are prepared to fund the proposal of Barry Edmonston of Cornell University for the analysis of WFS data in Bangladesh and Peru in the amount of \$125,000. Although this proposal had the highest technical rankings as the result of the research competition, clearances from Missions and from the WFS implementing organizations were not forthcoming in time for obligation in FY 1978. They have now been received, therefore this study is proposed for current-year funding. Another action to be undertaken is to support the work proposed by Charles Westoff and others of Princeton in connection with the East-West Center to examine WFS data available on the practice of sterilization in Korea, Sri Lanka, and Fiji, for approximately \$45,000. Each of these new activities provides a valuable extension to the WFS work in data gathering to the policy arena and is fully consistent with the aims of this project as originally undertaken.

In addition to the extension of activities, other smaller adjustments need to be made on projects already underway:

1. To amend without additional funding grant AID/pha-G-1185 with Research Triangle Institute for "The Development of an Econometric Fertility Model for Less Developed Countries," to extend the completion date from July 31, 1979, to December 31, 1979.
2. To extend without additional funding grant AID/pha-G-1181 with the University of North Carolina for the study, "How Female Education Reduces Fertility" in Latin America, from the originally proposed completion date of September 30, 1979, to August 31, 1980.
3. To extend without additional funding grant AID/pha-G-1171 with the Research Institute for the Study of Man to study "Opportunity Structures and Fertility Behavior among Women in Jamaica" from August 31, 1979, to December 31, 1979.
4. To add an additional \$14,000 for AID/pha-G-1201 with the Center for Policy Research in New York for the study of "Female Employment and Fertility in the Dominican Republic" to cover additional local costs for data processing and a policy development seminar disseminating the results of the research grant. The completion date of the project will also need to be extended from September 30, 1979, to March 31, 1980.
5. To add an additional \$54,000 to cover AID costs for the follow-up round of grant AID/pha-G-0014 with Boston University for a health and fertility interrelationship study in Nigeria. This extension is to be undertaken with the collaborative funding of the Overseas Development Ministry.
6. To add an additional \$67,000 to support the completion of the work of the International Review at the Collegio de Mexico through the Population Council programmatic grant. The work of this group has been supported only indirectly by AID, but has now been presented at the Bellagio meeting and has received important enthusiasm by donors. Plans are underway for a year of follow-up activities beginning in July. This report will form an important basis for the evolving strategy of the Policy Development Division, and its completion and follow-up should be supported.
7. To add an additional \$45,000 to cover extension of Grant AID/pha-G-1202 with the East-West Population Institute for the study of "Female Socio-economic Status Attainment, Marriage Decisions and Fertility Consequences: A Cross Cultural Study" in Pakistan. The General Counsel has advised that this is not in violation of Section 699 of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 as amended.

Each of these projects received clearance from relevant Missions at the time of grant award. The PAF for adding an additional year of funding, the Advice of Program Change, and the FY 1979 Activity Data Sheet required to implement the outlined program are attached. The life of project costs will total \$2,900,000 and falls within the original amount (\$3,000,000) of the previously approved project paper.

Recommendation: That you approve the attached PAF Amendment to project 932-0616 authorizing FY 1979 funding in the amount of \$390,000 extending the life of the project by one year, from FY 1978 to FY 1979, and that you sign the Notification to Congress.
