SUBJECT: Advance Copy Revised PROP: International Association of Schools of Social Work AIC/csd 2971

Clearance is requested for the attached PROP Revision which will extend the subject project for three years at a cost of \$997,000.

This will permit the project to complete activities in Asia, provide intensive assistance to African and Egyptian schools applying for project status in FY 76, and establish cooperating school relationships in Latin America where the political situation does not permit pilot school relationships.

The project will end in FY 79 with an international conference as a follow up to the AID conference in 1970, which served as the basis for the project. The future conference will include major donors and contractors in FP programs. This conference will summarize the successes and failures in population in the last decade and provide direction for future activities.

It would be appreciated if this PROP could be reviewed and returned no later than COB September 12, 1975.

Attached, for your signature, is the PROP amendment for the International Development for Qualified Social Work Manpower for Population Family/Planning project. This project was originally scheduled to continue through FY 1978, however, after a meeting with Mrs. Crowley, Gerry Winfield, Connie Collins, Mark Hayden and me, it was agreed that the project should be terminated before that date (see attached memo of October 16, 1975). It was also agreed that the contractor, International Association of Schools for Social Workers (IASSW), should receive funding in FY 1976 in order to allow for an orderly phaseout and an opportunity to obtain other donor support. This PROP amendment extends this activity for one additional year so that the Agency can provide an additional years funding for this phaseout.

The proposed FY 1976 funding level is shown on page 91 of the IPDB of the FY 1976 CP. This amendment has been cleared by PPC and will not require the Administrator's or Deputy Administrator's signature.

IASSW Project

On the 7th of October, I met with Gerry Winfield, Connie Collins, Dave McMakin, and Mark Hayden to discuss the course of action that the Bureau would take on IASSW.

All agreed that the project was proceeding very well; however, there was considerable discussion regarding the impact of the project on family planning programs as they have developed over the last several years -- and as we expect them to continue to develop in the years ahead. Based on the facts and the discussion presented, I recommended that the project be extended only one additional year rather than the proposed three year extension. It is hoped that the one year extension will permit an orderly AID phase out and will provide IASSW the opportunity to obtain other donor support.

All in attendance supported this recommendation and agreed to implement the actions required as quickly as possible.
