ACTION MEMORANDUM FOR THE ASSISTANT ADMINISTRATOR

Problem: Your approval is required to extend the project life of the Expansion of Program Communication project for one year.

Background: This project was initiated in FY 1971 to provide graduate level training in population program communication for LDC family planning personnel. The grantee, the University of Chicago, emphasized production of materials for inter-personnel, group and mass media programs, research in communication in LDC's as a discipline within the social sciences, and academic course work in behavioral sciences relevant to field family planning programs. The grantee also conducted summer workshops to train communicators in techniques for motivating individual couples, as well as in methods of reaching groups and the community at large.

The current project authority expired with FY 1975 funding and the current grant agreement expires on June 30, 1976, the day when the grantee is also expected to exhaust his available funds.

Discussion: It was originally intended that this project would be authorized for a final three years subject to the results of an intensive evaluation which was scheduled to occur in April 1976. Due to administrative problems the evaluation was not initiated. Due to the lateness of the fiscal year and the fact that the grantee has been given no advance notice of program termination, we believe that there is sufficient basis for one final year of funding. The authorization will specify that this additional year will be the final year of the project. It will have the effect of providing the grantee one year to proceed with an orderly phase-out of the current project and provide one year in which the PHA Bureau can prepare any appropriate new follow-on project which will be formulated to generate requisite communications training in LDC locales rather than in the U.S. Such a project will be based on an intensive evaluation of the old project and require a new Project Paper that must be approved by the Bureau and Agency.

Recommendation: That you extend the life of the project for one year to enable an orderly phase out.
