The basic target or purpose of the Project is to provide LDCs with an informational resource; in this case, better organized information on the educational finance and measurement problem area. The product of the Project will be a manual, or handbook, which will provide a "state-of-the-art" survey picture of educational finance and measurement in LDCs, and a specification of needed new research or other activities.

In order to insure that the manual is fully responsive to the needs felt by LDC planners and policy-makers, a final review conference will be held. This conference, scheduled for the concluding stages of the Project, and provided for in the original contract, will be expanded through this amendment to include a greater number of LDC participants and international experts, and will be held in a foreign location. It will serve the following purposes:

1. To provide for the review, in general terms, of the first draft of the manual by participants. The first draft of the manual will be completed by the Contractor on or about 1 January 1973, and copies will be sent to participants two to three weeks before the convening of the conference.
2. Specifically to enable participants to react to the feasibility, utility, and value of research and other activities suggested in the manual.
3. To elicit additional suggestions from participants for needed research and other activities.
4. To work out the best program of later distribution of the final published manual.

The Contractor will handle all aspects of the conference in consultation with the A.I.D. Project Manager, including the following:

1. Establish the format and organize the conference.
2. Select the conference site, and manage all logistics and other details of the actual holding of the conference.

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3. Prepare a final report of the conference, covering all aspects of the conference described in the original and amended contract. This report shall be submitted to A.I.D. within three weeks of the conclusion of the conference, and shall give specific directions as to the best plan for distribution of the final published manual.

The Contractor will invite at least two participants from a minimum of 12 developing countries, these developing countries to be identified by A.I.D. The Contractor will invite not more than 6 international educational finance experts.

The Contractor will utilize suggestions forthcoming from the review conference to revise the first draft of the manual. The final version of the manual shall be printed, with a durable binding, and two thousand (2000) copies shall be delivered to A.I.D. by 31 March 1973.

Other provisions of the contract shall remain unchanged.
