12. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

A. Summary

The overall purpose of this agreement between A.I.D. and the Department of Commerce, National Bureau of Standards, is to provide funds for four months services of an NBS specialist, Dr. Raymond C. Sangster, to assist the Bureau of Development Support, Office of Science and Technology, to contribute to U.S. preparation for and participation in the U.N. Conference on Science and Technology for Development (UNCSTD).

B. Scope of Work

In particular, the PASA technician will provide advisory services on industrial research to strengthen U.S. preparation for discussions in this field at subsequent UNCSTD meetings and at the August 1979 Conference. He will:

13. GOVERNING PROVISIONS: PURSUANT TO THE GENERAL AGREEMENT DATED Feb. 20, 1967 BETWEEN AID AND THE COM/NBS, THE AGENCY NAMED ABOVE AGREES TO PROVIDE THE SERVICES OUTLINED IN BLOCK 12 AMPLIFIED AS NEEDED BY APPENDIX A UNLESS OTHERWISE AUTHORIZED BY AID. ALL SERVICES SHALL BE OF U.S. ORIGIN. ANY APPENDICES ATTACHED HERETO ARE CONSIDERED PART OF THIS PASA.

(1) Review and comment on reports, position papers and related materials for UNCSTD with reference to the role of U.S. industrial research; (2) Advise and assist NBS in connection with the workshop on technological knowledge requirements for industrializing countries to be held at NBS in October 1978. Dr. Sangster will assist in organizing and reporting on the workshop with special reference to the role of industrial research; (3) Advise and assist the International Science and Technology Institute in connection with the Industrial Research Institute workshop on the role of U.S. industrial research institutes in science and technology to be held in Rosslyn, Virginia, November 1978.

This workshop is being funded by AID through a purchase order being negotiated with ISTI. Dr. Sangster will advise ISTI on important aspects of industrial research relevant to the ECLA discussions which should be considered in organizing and conducting the IRI workshop; (4) Monitor and participate in various government and non-government meetings related to U.S. preparation of UNCSTD in which the subject of industrial research may be a significant factor; and (5) other tasks as may be assigned by AID/DS/ST related to the role of U.S. industrial research institutes on S & T for development.

C. Reports

1. At the end of the four-month period, December 31, 1978, the PASA technician will submit a narrative report (original and one copy) to AID/DS/ST, describing the scope of his services in connection with U.S. preparation for UNCSTD.

2. In addition, he will submit three copies of all reports listed as being a product of this PASA (administrative, progress, final and technical reports containing R&D findings) to the Documentation Coordinator, DS/DIU/DI, Development Support Bureau, AID/W, D.C. 20523, or his designee. Such reports will include a title page showing the title of the report, project title as set forth in this PASA, and the PASA number. One copy of each report will be clearly typed or printed on white paper so that it may be photographed to produce a microfilm master. Technical reports will be accompanied by an author-prepared abstract.

D. Liaison and Guidance

AID/W liaison officials - Dr. William L. Eilers, AID UNCSTD Coordinator, Project Director.

The PASA technician will work under the general supervision of Dr. Eilers, and/or his assistant Mr. John Fry.

E. Duty Station

Dr. Sangster is expected to provide approximately 2 months of his services in Washington, D.C. and additional two months in Denver, Colorado.
