

Pursuant to Part I, Chapter 1, Section 104 of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, I hereby approve a total level of A.I.D. appropriated funding planned for this Family Planning Assistance thru Home Economics project of not to exceed three million, six hundred and sixty four thousand United States Dollars (\$3,664,000) of which the entire amount will be grant funded during the period FY 1978 through FY 1982 in accordance with the attached PP. I authorize funding of \$500,000 of FY 78 funds for the first year of this project, the current limit of the FY 78 funds available for this project.

ACTION MEMORANDUM FOR THE ASSISTANT ADMINISTRATOR

July 27, 1978

Problem: Your approval is needed for a new Project Paper for Family Planning Assistance thru Home Economics (new project number 936-3006) and your authorization for five years of grant funding not to exceed three million, six hundred sixty four thousand United States Dollars (\$3,664,000).

Discussion: This PP provides for a new project which carries forward in concentrated form the program of P/FP information and service delivery through formal and informal home economic systems in selected LDCs. On the suggestion of the Noncompetitive Procurement Review Board this new project will operate as a grant to AHEA since it is the only international membership organization of Home Economists that now works in the population family planning field. This PP provides for concentration of attention on 16 emphasis countries that have strong Home Economics infrastructures with less assistance for up to 15 additional countries where Home Economics is less well developed. The thrust of the effort will be to institutionalize the provision of information, education and services in population and family planning into formal and informal home economics systems by developing well rounded country programs. Population and family planning will be integrated into home economics teaching and extension processes. Past experience and thorough evaluation have already demonstrated the effectiveness of this activity. This PP was discussed at an Inter-Agency Review Meeting which met in room 3676 N.S. on Thursday, July 13. Following revisions suggested then, it has been cleared by the Regional Bureaus and PPC.

Recommendation: That you approve the project and proposed funding by signing the attached Allotment of Funds, Part II, and approve the Environmental Threshold Determination (Annex C).
