PROJECT DESCRIPTION

1. Project Title: Diversified Secondary
Education Workshop

Peru has adopted diversified secondary education as its official policy. This means that students at the high school level can opt for an academic or a vocational education track. The vocational track is closely linked to the AID-financed "Education Service Centers Project (527-0148)". The Ministry of Education is seriously considering replication of the Education Service Centers model on a national scale as a means to offer practical vocational training to the largest number of students with a minimum investment for infrastructure and equipment. Therefore, the proposed Diversified Secondary Education Workshop will directly impact on decisions related to the replication of an AID-financed pilot project and will also result in useful transfer of information to the Ministry of Education for more efficient and effective operation of the four AID financed centers even if national replication does not occur.

I. General Description

The workshop will take place in the city of Lima from May 17 through May 21, 1982. Eighty five participants will be selected from among the various offices of the Ministry of Education (MOE) at the national level to attend the workshop.

Experts from Colombia and Mexico will be invited to give lectures on the models of Diversified Secondary Education in their respective countries. Ministry of Education and Ministry of Labor officials will also participate as instructors.

II. Purpose

- (1) To analyze experiences of diversified secondary education in Latin American countries, and
- (2) To establish criteria for the planning, organization and implementation of diversified secondary education processes in Peru.

III. Responsibility of the Parties

- (1) The AID contribution will finance the following items: room and board for participants, air tickets and per diem for lecturers, and transportation costs for participants within the maximum limitation as set out in Attachment B, Standard Provisions. Subject to the availability of funds, AID may provide an additional contribution, for supplies and materials.
- (2) The Ministry of Education will assume responsibility for the overall coordination and administration of workshop. In addition, the Ministry of Education will defray the salaries of the participants and costs related to printing, supplies and rental of equipment, as indicated in Item IV, Budget.
