A. Purpose of Grant:

The purpose of this Grant is to provide assistance for TRRM project entitled "A Village Management System for Integrated Rural Development" during the period from August 31, 1980 to August 31, 1983.

The Grant will enable TRRM to work in the 48 selected villages of Chainat and Uthaitani Provinces in developing a village management system. The project is also aimed at motivating local leaders to make a contribution towards the development of programs for solving economic and social problems. Approximately 11,660 people will be direct beneficiaries of this project.

B. Specific Objectives and Implementation:

The project financed by this Grant and its manner of implementation are described in TRRM's proposal dated July 16, 1980. (Annex D)

C. Reporting:

TRRM will prepare and submit detailed, semi-annual reports from the data accepted by the Grantee and such reports will become due within 30 days following the 6th, 12th, 18th, 30th months of the project. They will describe the progress and problems of project activities as set forth in the project proposal. An evaluation will be conducted by TRRM, cooperating RTG agency and USAID if it desires, and a report thereon submitted to USAID/T within 30 days following completion of the first year of the project to determine if the project is on target and to recommend any necessary adjustments for the project. A final evaluation will be due within thirty days following the 36th month of the project which will be in sufficient detail so that AID can judge the effectiveness of the project and the efficiency by which it was implemented.

2. The Grant amount of US\$138,000 represents the total contribution of AID for this project. The TRRM will provide an additional US\$83,862 to the project. Additional funds required to complete the project will be provided by the Grantee from other sources.

3. After the Agreement has become effective, an initial release of funds for the project will be made upon submission by TRRM through the Department of Technical and Economic Cooperation (DTEC) of the Royal Thai Government (RTG) to the Controller, USAID, Office of Finance, of Voucher Standard Form 1034, in original and three (3) copies requesting disbursement of an amount equal to the AID share of anticipated requirements for authorized expenditure by budget line item, for the ensuing three months. As soon as feasible after the end of the second month, and every three months thereafter,

TRRM will submit through DTEC to USAID an accounting of the previous period's expenditures of the funds advanced by AID, certified correct by an authorized TRRM official, together with Voucher SF-1034 requesting reimbursement for such expenditures. The TRRM will also submit at 6 month intervals accounting of expenditures for the non-AID portion of the budget. Beginning with the third request for reimbursement and every three months thereafter reimbursement of the previous month's activity will be contingent on the submission of the required status reports of the project program described in paragraph C above.

4. On or before October 31, 1983 TRRM shall forward to DTEC and USAID a detailed final accounting report, using the format in Annex C, on the status of funds granted herein, listing all expenditures by budget line item, together with a check made payable to the American Embassy, Bangkok refunding any grant funds properly returnable to USAID under the terms of the Agreement.

5. The funds provided shall be used to finance the item set forth in Annex A. It is understood that the Grantee may make adjustments among line items of up to 25% of the amount of any line items provided, however, the total amount of the grant may not be exceeded.



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


