Direct contribution by other donors comes principally from FAO. FAO is making the greater contribution to laboratory facilities at the University of Guayaquil, which will be essential for improving crop production under the loans. The laboratories have been built and are being equipped. It is also just starting a program to build up the Agricultural Extension Service. The Agricultural Division have frequent contacts with their key personnel; coordination and cooperation is excellent.

To assist in the implementation of the agricultural diversification (\$7.2 million) and land sale guaranty (\$3.6 million) loans.

e. 1. Conditions which will exist when above purpose is achieved.

- 1. Loans disbursed and loan purposes achieved.
- 2. A functional capability within the Ministry of Production to provide technical assistance and seed materials.
- 3. The Central Bank able to implement these loans and able to design and implement new loans.

2. Evidence to date of progress toward these conditions.

- 1. Agricultural Diversification loan is not yet signed. Good progress is being made toward meeting conditions precedent for the land sale guaranty loan. Both loans have been planned in detail.
- 2. a) Ministry of Production already has much of the equipment needed for seed processing; b) has a small functioning organization for certified seed production; and c) has released one key staff member for participant training. Also the Ministry has begun to reorganize its extension service to make it more effective, and has initiated a program of evaluating this effectiveness.
- 3. a) The Trust Fund is established and making progress toward developing operating regulations; b) it has nucleus staff on board; and c) it has personnel under training for designing new loan plans.

V. PROGRAMMING GOAL

A. Statement of Programming Goal

To expand the production of selected agricultural crops and improve foreign exchange To promote a more equitable distribution of income

To increase the participation of low income groups in the political, social and economic life of the country.

Implementation of the two loans, as above stated under Statement of Purpose, will result in significant contributions to the programming goals.
