I. Introduction and Summary

This is the final progress report for Grant AID/pha-G-1116. Funds provided under this grant were made available for activities begun prior to 16 May 1983. This report includes narrative progress reports and financial information for each subaward, subcontract, or in-house activity supported under Grant AID/pha-G-1116 in 1984. As in past years, the progress reports are presented by region and in-house activities (including subawards and subcontracts entered into as part of Council in-house activities under the Grant) and the summary of 1984 activities is divided into interregional activities, regional activities, and country-specific activities. In 1984, a total of 8 projects was active; all were started in prior years.

Interregional Activities

In 1984, support was continued in contraceptive development for a study on the effect of levonorgestrel IUDs on rabbit endometrium using the New Zealand white rabbit as an experimental animal at the University of Western Ontario. Support was also continued for studies on the effects of contraceptive steroids on atherogenesis, lipoprotein patterns, and general health using the cynomolgus monkey as an experimental animal at Wake Forest University; comparative clinical studies to evaluate the effectiveness and safety of the levonorgestrel and TCu 380Ag IUDs at the Centro Nacional de la Familia; and studies on comparative use-effectiveness of NORPLANT® and NORPLANT®-2 contraceptive implants at the University of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey at Rutgers Medical School and San Francisco General Hospital at the University of California, San Francisco.

Regional Activities

In Latin America, support was continued for the Spanish Translation Program. During the 38 months of the project conducted by Corporacion Centro Regional de Poblacion (CCRP) under this program, a total of 25 publications were prepared for distribution. In the Middle East, support was continued for the Population Council in-house project, Population Analysis Techniques for Planners in the Middle East and publication of a monograph entitled Population Factors in Development Planning in the Middle East. The monograph has been published and is being distributed in the Middle East. Ten copies are also being sent to AID along with this report.

Country-Specific Activities

In Brazil, support was continued for the Copper-T IUD training and evaluation in medical schools in Brazil project conducted by Centro de Pesquisas e Controle das Doencas Materno-Infantis de Campinas (CEMI-CAMP). During the project more than 23,500 IUDs were delivered to 20 clinics participating in the study; almost 21,000 were inserted; and a total of 28 people were trained in IUD insertion.

Purpose: To increase effective knowledge on population and family planning in Latin America by producing and distributing Spanish language population publications.

The Council has supported a Spanish translation and distribution program since 1966. Since its inception, this program based in Mexico and Colombia has been modified to adapt to the changing needs of the region and its audience, and to improve the quality of the publications. This award to the CCRP was an effort to provide timely and useful information on population to a broad audience of policy makers, researchers and institutions. Specifically, the objective was to increase the effective knowledge on population and family planning in Latin America by producing and distributing twenty-four language publications.

During the thirty-eight months of the project, a total of twenty-five publications were prepared for distribution. The editorial committee, composed of professionals from the CCRP and the Representative of the Population Council, was responsible for the definition of the target population, review and selection of themes, insuring the quality of translations and updating the mailing list. Articles were selected primarily from working papers and regular publications of the Population Council and the CCRP. The effort to solicit original publications from professionals on the mailing list met with little success.

Purpose: To support Copper-T IUD training and evaluation in medical
schools in Brazil.

The Council supported a project to the Universidade Estadual de Campinas to provide Copper-T IUD training and evaluation in Brazil. This project provided support for salaries, materials and supplies (including IUDs), costs for training, travel, data processing, and other administrative expenses associated with promoting the evaluation of Copper-T IUDs by Brazilian Medical schools in order to attain local proficiency in the use of the device and provide useful input toward an official government decision to allow the unrestricted utilization of IUDs in Brazil.

The final phase of our award to CEMICAMP focused on analyzing data obtained by the clinics and assisting in the publication of these results. Ten clinics have their data analyzed and have prepared papers to be published in Brazilian journals.

During the project, more than 23,500 IUDs were delivered to twenty clinics participating in the study; almost 21,000 were inserted. A total of twenty-eight people were trained in IUD insertion during the award period.

In addition, a short-term course in contraception was given in Goiania, (the capital of the state of Goias). Goias will be the first state to implement the official program of Integrated Women's Health Care.

Purpose: To continue studies on the effects of contraceptive steroids on atherogenesis, lipoprotein patterns, and general health using the cynomolgus monkey as an experimental animal.

The protocol called for use of four groups of cynomolgus monkeys. One group was to receive levonorgestrel and estradiol via a vaginal ring; a second was to receive levonorgestrel and ethynylestradiol via oral administration; a third was to be fitted with placebo rings and the fourth was to be a group of male animals. The animals were to be administered a mildly atherogenic diet and measurements of lipoprotein concentrations and serum chemistry parameters made at intervals throughout the study. At sacrifice, accurate measurements were to be made of areas of atherosclerotic involvement in the coronary arteries as well as in selected additional arteries.

The protocol was successfully carried out as planned and sacrifice of the animals and measurement of atherosclerotic involvement conducted. The findings indicate trends toward more atherosclerotic involvement in the ring group than in the control group and less in the group receiving levonorgestrel and ethynylestradiol orally. They also indicate that the predictive value of lipoprotein patterns for the development of atherosclerosis may be considerably altered by steroid administration. The amount of coronary artery atherosclerosis increased with decreasing high density lipoprotein--cholesterol (HDL-C) levels in all groups but in the Ovral group became significant only at much lower HDL-C levels than in other groups.

Purpose: To organize and conduct a study on the effect of levonorgestrel IUDs on rabbit endometrium using the New Zealand white rabbit as an experimental animal.

The objective of this project is to determine whether long term exposure of the endometrium results in an increase or decrease in the incidence of endometrial cancer. This is one aspect of evaluating the potential safety of the levonorgestrel IUD device. Devices releasing levonorgestrel were placed in the uteri of 50 rabbits and placebo devices placed in the uteri of a second group of 50. Rabbits of 2.5 years of age were used in order to enhance the chances of development of endometrial cancer during the two years of the study. Laparotomies were carried out before assigning the animals to the study in order to eliminate animals that had already developed hyperplasia. Laparotomy to follow endometrial changes was carried out at six months and one year.

The study had reached the one-year point at the end of this contract. Four animals had developed hyperplasia. Since examination of the animals is being done on a blind basis, it is not known whether they were in the treated or placebo group. One concern in the study has been loss of devices from some of the animals in spite of their having been sutured in place.

This study represents one unit of a multi-clinic randomized comparison of a levonorgestrel-releasing IUD and a copper IUD, the TCu 380Ag. The protocol called for enrolling 100 subjects on each of the two devices at this site. Information is being gathered on pregnancy rates, termination rates by cause, and continuation rates.

Enrollment was completed in March 1984. Effectiveness has been excellent and continuation rates satisfactory. The number of patients lost to follow-up has been small.

The objective of this project is to obtain clinical data on the performance of two subdermal implant systems releasing levonorgestrel. One of the systems (NORPLANT^R) utilizes six capsules; the other (NORPLANT^R-2) utilizes two covered rods. 175 subjects are to be enrolled on NORPLANT^R-2 implants and 75 on NORPLANT^R implants at this clinic, which is one of three clinics in the US participating in these comparative studies.

Patient enrollment is proceeding relatively slowly at this site but is accelerating. 138 women have been enrolled. Performance of both devices has been highly satisfactory as judged by effectiveness, side effects and continuation rates.

The objective of this project is to obtain clinical data on the performance of two subdermal implant systems releasing levonorgestrel. Recruitment of subjects was initially slower than desired, due partly to delays in hiring the necessary personnel. Enrollment is now proceeding satisfactorily and a total of 185 women has been recruited. Performance of both implants forms is quite satisfactory as judged by effectiveness, side effects and continuation rates.
