Problem: Your approval is requested to extend the authorized final year of obligation for the Nutrition in Agricultural Research Centers Project (931-1124) to FY 1986. No increase in authorized life of project funding is required.

Background: Under this project, S&T/N on September 9, 1979 awarded a grant (AID/DSAN-G-0174) to the Asian Vegetable Research and Development Center (AVRDC). Under the grant, AVRDC was to (a) introduce a nutrition/utilization dimension into its research and extension program, and (b) assist Asian countries served by the center to alter agricultural practices to meet the nutritional requirements of their populations. A home and school garden program was identified by AVRDC as the best mechanism to achieve these objectives.

By the end of the first year of the grant, this project was sufficiently successful that the AID Asia Bureau (now ANE) funded an add-on component for in-depth socioeconomic analysis of the gardens which had been developed as prototypes for transfer to the different Asian countries. ANE and S&T have funded the grant on a cost-sharing basis over the past four years because it contributes to mutual objectives of the two bureaus. Outreach assistance under the grant to Thailand has been underway to Thailand for over two years, and has been initiated in Indonesia, the Philippines, Indonesia, Sri Lanka and Nepal.

Funding limitations have precluded absorption of this activity within the AVRDC core budget, as was originally agreed, and AID missions in the aforementioned countries have only recently become strongly supportive. Thus, alternate funding arrangements to AID/W support are not yet in place. S&T and ANE have therefore agreed to cost-share activities under the grant for up to an additional year.

The AVRDC grant is currently funded through September 30, 1985. It is projected that there will be an unexpended balance in the grant of approximately \$5,000 as of that date. ANE has agreed to provide \$30,000 of FY 1985 funds and S&T/FA will contribute \$25,000 of FY 1986 funds to continue ongoing activities under the grant for as long as possible during FY 1986, but not beyond September 30, 1986.

Recommendation: That you approve the extension of the authorized final year of obligation for the Nutrition in Agricultural Research Centers Project to FY 1986 by signing the enclosed Project Authorization.
