

2. The authorization remains in force except as hereby amended.





Qualification under Section 621 (a) of the Foreign Assistance Act

Under the RSSA agreement being requested by the attached documentation the Office of International Development Cooperative (OICD) of the USDA will provide technical assistance to selected developing countries in the economic and consumption analysis of agricultural policies. OICD has a particular capability for the work to be done under this agreement because of previously established working relationships with the countries to be assisted and existing experience analyzing the consumption impact of agricultural policies. Because of the complex institutional relationships involved this work is particularly suited to the USDA Nutrition Economics Group (NEG) and would not be of interest to firms in the private sector.

I hereby determine in accordance with the factors described above that the proposed RSSA with OICD/USDA qualifies under Section 621 (a) of the Foreign Assistance Act because it is (for technical assistance, (2) OICD is particularly qualified for this scope of work, and (3) this actions is not competitive with the private sector

ACTION MEMORANDUM FOR THE AGENCY DIRECTOR FOR FOOD AND AGRICULTURE

SUBJECT: FY 85 Funding for Nutrition: Consumption Analysis of
Agricultural Policies RSSA (931-1171)

Problem: To authorize \$550,000 in FY 85 funding to provide for the continuation of RSSA BST-1171-R-AG-3125-02 with the USDA Office of International Cooperation and Development (OICD) through December 31, 1985, and \$98,955 to incrementally fund grant DAN-1275-G-SS-2124-00 with the International Food Policy Research Institute.

Discussion: Since 1977, S&T/N has utilized the services of the USDA Nutrition Economics Group (NEG) under Project 931-1171 to help further A.I.D.'s goal of incorporating nutrition concerns into agricultural policies, programs and projects.

Demand for RSSA services continues. Although a project paper is in the draft stages of preparation, the follow-on project which will encompass Consumption Effects of Agricultural Policies and Subsidized Consumption as well as core RSSA support is not in place. This authorization would permit the continuation of activities under the RSSA while the Project Design Team finalizes work on the project paper and new project authority is granted.

In March, 1985 the grant with the International Food Policy Research Institute (IFPRI) to study the Sri Lankan food stamp program was amended to expand the scope of work and be more responsive to the GOSL. Although this grant was originally funded under the Nutrition: Subsidized Consumption Project (931-1275), the three nutrition economics projects were subsumed into 931-1171 beginning in FY 85.

Recommendation I: That you authorize a total of \$648,955 in FY 85 funding by signing the attached PAF.

Recommendation II: That you sign the attached Section 621(a) determination for the referenced RSSA.
