NAME OF COUNTRY: Worldwide  
NAME OF PROJECT: Nutrition Health Systems (RSSA)  
PROJECT NUMBER: 931-1198

1. Pursuant to Section 103 of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, the Nutrition Health Systems (RSSA) which is centrally funded was amended on July 11, 1985. That Authorization is hereby amended as follows:
  - a. The authorization year of obligation is extended to FY 1986.
  - b. Obligation of \$325,000 in FY 86 funding is authorized.
2. The work envisaged by this project is exempt from the provision of A-76 because (1) it is for the provision of technical assistance, and (2) the facilities and resources of the Department of Health and Human Services are particularly suitable for the technical assistance being sought and are not competitive with private enterprise.

**ACTION MEMORANDUM FOR THE AGENCY DIRECTOR FOR FOOD AND AGRICULTURE**

**FROM:** S&T/N, Martin J. Forman / *Martin J. Forman*  
**SUBJECT:** Authorization of FY 86 funding for Nutrition - Health Systems RSSA - *0000*

**Problem:** Approval is requested for (1) the continuation of RSSA BST-0249-R-HI-2254-07 with the Office of International Health (OIH) of the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) through December 31, 1986; and (2) the provision of \$325,000 in FY 86 funding in support of the RSSA's activities.

**Discussion:** Technical assistance in the integration of nutrition components with Primary Health Care (PHC) delivery systems continues to be a need in developing countries. There is a growing awareness among health and nutrition planners in developing countries that there is an interaction between health and nutrition factors. In order to foster this awareness this project through a RSSA with HHS provides the impetus for the incorporation and/or strengthening of nutrition concerns to improve the health of infants and young children and pregnant and lactating women.

Technical assistance has been provided on site to Ecuador, Peru, Jamaica, Dominican Republic, Somalia, Liberia, Thailand, Sierra Leone and India, including workshops in Africa. Additional workshops are planned for Africa and Peru. This project is also providing assistance for adding dietary management components to diarrheal disease control programs and for including growth monitoring in PHC.

**Recommendation:** That you authorize the continuation of the Nutrition Health Systems RSSA project through December 31, 1986 and the provision of \$325,000 in FY 85 funding in support of project activities by signing the attached PAF, Part II.
