


ACTION MEMORANDUM FOR THE AGENCY DIRECTOR FOR FOOD AND AGRICULTURE

SUBJECT: Extension and Increase in Project Authorization for  
Nutrition Education Field Support Project (931-1065)

Problem: To extend the authorized period of obligation of the Nutrition Education Field Support Project until September 30, 1986, and to increase the authorized funding level of the project by \$450,000 for a new total of \$2,641,000.

Discussion: On September 30, 1979, A.I.D. approved a three year project to undertake activities to improve/maintain the nutritional status of "at risk" groups in developing countries through more effective nutrition education programs and projects. That project was subsequently amended for 2 additional years thru 9/30/85.

Given the fact that there are a number of nutrition education activities still in process, the Office of Nutrition would like to extend the project for a period of one year (i.e., until December 31, 1986) at an increased funding level of \$450,000. The one year extension would provide the amount of time necessary to complete a follow-on project paper, invite and review technical proposals and complete the contractor selection process without a hiatus in nutrition education activities already underway.

In addition, an increase in the authorized funding level of the project by \$450,000 would permit the Office of Nutrition, through a cooperative agreement with Educational Development Center's International Nutrition Communication Service (INCS), to undertake the following:

- 1) Continue to provide technical assistance to the Jamaica Primary Education Nutrition Project.
- 2) Continue to provide technical assistance to The Gambian Maternal Nutrition Initiatives
- 3) Continue to provide assistance to help strengthen the communications component of the Ecuador MOH/Child Survival program.
- 4) Provide technical assistance to the UNICEF/MOH Growth Monitoring and Nutrition Education Pilot Project in Sudan.

5) Prepare case studies on the Philippine and another National Nutrition Program.

6) Provide technical assistance to the DR CRS/Caritas community nutrition program

Recommendation: That you authorize a one-year extension in the period of obligation, thru 9/30/86, and a \$450,000 increase in project funding to \$2,641,000 for the Nutrition Education Field Support Project by signing the attached PAF, Part II.
