

1. Pursuant to Section 104 of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, the centrally-funded project, Technology for Primary Health Care was authorized on April 26, 1983. That authorization was amended on May 8, 1985 to increase the life of project funding for centrally-funded obligations from \$12,000,000 to \$25,000,000; to increase the amount that may be contributed by Regional Bureaus and A.I.D. Missions from \$7,000,000 to \$15,000,000; and to include technical assistance for financing, training, design and evaluation to the project description. That authorization is hereby amended, as follows:

(a) Authorize the use of \$4,700,000 of grant funds available under Section 104 (c)(2)(B) (Child Survival), thereby increasing the life of project funding for centrally funded obligations from \$25,000,000 to \$29,700,000.

2. The authorization cited above remains in effect except as modified herein.

SUBJECT: Increased Authority for Use of Child Survival Funds in an Expanded Child Survival Program for the Project Technology for Primary Health Care (936-5927)

Problem: Your approval is needed to authorize use of Child Survival (CS) funds and to increase the Life of Project funding amount accordingly for this project which will receive Child Survival funds under a separate FY 1986 budget line item.

Discussion: The Child Survival Fund was established in 1985. A.I.D.'s child survival activities are assisted broadly by projects funded under the regular Health (HE) account. In FY 1986 and 1987, A.I.D. will accelerate a number of health activities of direct importance to child survival. Through a separate budget line item, the Child Survival Fund will provide significant support to the Agency's child survival field programs through the provision of technical support, training and research. The project purpose has not changed, but the additional funds will permit the Agency to concentrate additional efforts in countries where infant and child mortality is high and host governments are committed to improving child survival prospects. Because additional funds made available under this expanded program are additive to the current project LOP, the project authorization is being amended.

An Advice of Program Change is in the clearance process.

Recommendation: (1) That you approve the use of Child Survival Funds for expanded program activities by signing below; and (2) that you approve the increase to the project LOP by signing the amended project authorization attached.
