



1. Pursuant to Section 103 of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, the Area Development Project was authorized on January 3, 1978. The project was renamed the Human Settlements and Natural Resource Systems Analysis (SARSA) and was extended through FY 84 on July 18, 1983. The authorization is hereby amended as follows:

- a. The authorization is extended from FY 84 through FY 88.
 - b. The life-of-project cost is increased from \$2,744,000 to \$5,344,000 (including FY 84), a total of \$2,600,000 in core funds.
 - c. The additional contribution of incremental funding from other Bureaus and Missions is expected to reach \$5,000,000, producing a total life-of-project funding level of \$10,344,000.
2. The authorization cited above remains in force except as hereby agreed.
3. Sources and Origin of Goods and Services
- a. Each development country where training or other assistance taken place under this project shall be deemed to be a cooperating country for the purpose of permitting local cost financing.
 - b. Goods and services, except for ocean shipping, financed by A.I.D. under the project shall have their source and origin in a cooperating country or in the United States except as A.I.D. may otherwise agree in writing.
 - c. Ocean shipping financed by A.I.D. under the project shall, except as A.I.D. may otherwise agree in writing, be financed only on flag vessels of the United States.

ACTION MEMORANDUM TO THE AGENCY DIRECTOR FOR HUMAN RESOURCES FOR SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

FROM: S&T/RD, John O'Donnell 

SUBJECT: Human Settlements and Natural Resource Systems Analysis (SARSA) Project (931-1135) and Cooperative Agreement with Clark University/Institute for Development Anthropology

Problem: We request that you authorize a four year extension of the life of the Human Settlements and Natural Resource Systems Analysis (SARSA) Project to September 30, 1988, by signing the attached PAF. Further, we request that you increase the ceiling for the Cooperative Agreement from the current level of \$1,946,035 to \$9,546,035 with the increase being \$2,600,000 of core funding and \$5,000,000 in incremental funding.

Discussion: On June 17, 1983, the former Area Development Project was given a one year extension to September 30, 1984, using a Cooperative Agreement with Clark University/Institute for Development Anthropology for carrying out the activities of the project. On July 18, 1983, the Human Resources Sector Council reviewed and approved a project paper amendment, extending the project (now the Human Settlements and Natural Resource System Analysis - SARSA) to September 30, 1988. The Rural Development members unanimously endorsed the extension, with no outstanding issues.

The mechanism for research activities of the SARSA project for FY 84 is a Cooperative Agreement with Clark University/Institute for Development Anthropology. They have begun a research program within the topics of SARSA project, have developed a coherent plan to carry out research for the life of the project, and have preliminarily identified the research outputs to be delivered by the end of FY 88. We have approved their workplan for FY 84 which launches the renamed project.

To carry out the research program, the authorization ceiling needs to be raised to incorporate both the core funding and the incremental funding by missions. The core funding would total \$2.6 million through annual increments of \$400,000 for FY 84 (not yet obligated); \$600,000 for FY 85, FY 86, and FY 87; and \$400,000 for FY 88. We anticipate a total incremental funding by missions to be \$5.0 million. Our best estimate is that the SARSA Cooperative Agreement would need at least four countries for each of four research themes to test the research methodologies being developed. Overall, we anticipate a total of eighteen countries, as indicated in the attached table (FYI). These mission buy-ins to the Cooperative Agreement research program will be long term research efforts under the scope of work of the Cooperative Agreement.

Recommendation: That you authorize a four year extension of the SARSA project through FY 88; and that you authorize an increase in the level of cost for the Cooperative Agreement from \$1,946,035 to \$9,546,035 to allow for an increase in core funds and incremental mission funds, by signing the attached PAF.
