1. Pursuant to Section 103 of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, the Nutrition: Consumption Analysis of Agricultural Policies project which is centrally funded was authorized on April 5, 1977. That project authorization has been amended eight times, the most recent of which is dated July 29, 1985. That authorization is hereby amended further as follows:
 - a. Life of project funding is increased in the amount of \$413,000 in FY 86 funding, from \$3,390,000 to \$3,803,000 to finance the cost of services required for the project through December 31, 1986.
2. The authorization remains in force except as hereby amended.

SUBJECT: FY 86 Funding for Nutrition: Consumption Analysis of
Agricultural Policies RSSA (931-1171)

Problem: To authorize \$413,000 in FY 86 funding to provide for the continuation of RSSA BST-1171-R-AG-3125-02 with the USDA Office of International Cooperation and Development (OICD) through December 31, 1986.

Background: Since 1977, S&T/N has utilized the services of the USDA Nutrition Economics Group (NEG) under Project 931-1171 to help further A.I.D.'s goals of (1) incorporating nutrition and food consumption considerations into agricultural policies, programs and projects; and (2) incorporating economic analysis into nutrition policy making, planning and program design.

Discussion: Mission demand for RSSA technical services continues in the areas of household income and expenditure (and related) survey design and analysis, data management and analysis, training materials and curriculum development, studies of policy impacts on food consumption, methodologies for policy assessment and design, and nutritional evaluation of agricultural projects. Although a Project Design Team is currently working on completion of a Project Paper (PP) for a project that is a follow-on consolidation and evolution from three earlier projects, the new project is not yet formally in place. This authorization would permit the continuation of activities under the RSSA prior to the completion and approval of the Project Paper and granting of new project authority.

Recommendation I: That you authorize \$413,000 in FY 86 funding for the USDA Nutrition Economic RSSA by signing the attached PAF, Part II.

Recommendation II: That you sign the attached Section 621 (a) determination for the referenced RSSA.

SUBJECT: 621 (a) Determination to Amend RSSA with the U.S.
Department of Agriculture to support the Nutrition:
Consumption Analysis of Agriculture Policies Project
(931-1171)

Problem: Your signature is required to indicate that you have determined that the subject RSSA is exempt from the provisions of OMB Circular A-76, under the provisions of Section 621(a) of the Foreign Assistance Act.

Background: The Nutrition: Consumption Analysis of Agriculture Policies project is authorized to, and funded under, Section 103 (Agriculture, Rural Development and Nutrition) of the Foreign Assistance Act. The project is directly supportive of nutrition and agriculture through its assistance in the analysis of consumption effects of LDC agriculture policies. Technical assistance services to be supplied under this RSSA include: data processing and analysis of household expenditure data, urban consumption surveys, preparation of a handbook on processing income and expenditure survey data, and development testing of workshop training materials for incorporating nutrition into agriculture projects and policies.

Justification: The U.S. Department of Agriculture's Nutrition Economics Group is particularly qualified to provide the services of agriculture economists who specialize in consumption analysis since it is the primary U.S. Government source of technical knowledge and experience in the combined fields of 1) nutrition and food consumption, as it relates to LDC agriculture policies, programs and projects; 2) incorporation of economic analysis into nutrition policy, and planning; and 3) its own technical assistance programs, network of international agricultural economist advisers, in-house research, international training, policy analysis programs and official ties to the international agriculture community provide an invaluable and unique cross fertilizing environment for the support of this nutrition in agriculture project.

We conclude that because of (a) the above described particular technical advantage, and (b) the historical relative cost advantage of similar agreements with USDA, neither private enterprise nor any

other U.S. Government Agency can provide this extensive range of experience and contacts at a similar price and therefore are deemed not to be competitive with the USDA.

Recommendation: That you sign the following 621(a) certification:

I hereby determine, in accordance with the factors described above that the proposed RSSA with USDA qualifies for exemption from the provision of OMB Circular A-76 under Section 621(a) of the Foreign Assistance Act because (1) it is for technical assistance; (2) the USDA is particularly suitable for this scope of work, and (3) it is not competitive with the private sector.
