

1. Pursuant to Section 104 of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, the centrally-funded project, Oral Rehydration Therapy-Health Education and Long-Term Planning was authorized on January 9, 1984. That authorization is hereby amended, as follows:

(a) Authorize the use of \$2,500,000 for Health and \$2,000,000 for Child Survival of grant funds available under Section 104 (c) (2) (B), Child Survival and Health Account, thereby increasing the life of project funding for centrally funded obligations from \$4,800,000 to \$9,300,000.

(b) Extend the final fiscal year of obligation to FY 1990 and the project assistance completion date to December 31, 1991.



2. The authorization cited above remains in effect except as modified herein.

ACTION MEMORANDUM FOR THE AGENCY DIRECTOR FOR HEALTH

SUBJECT: Increased Authority for Use of Health and Child
Survival Funds in the Oral Rehydration Therapy-Health
Education and Long-Term Planning (ORT-HELP) Project
(936-5939).

PROBLEM: Your approval is needed to authorize an increase in Health (HE) funds; the use of Child Survival (CS) funds; and increase overall the life of project funding from \$4,800,000 to \$9,300,000. The life of project funding period is extended from FY 1987 to FY 1990; thus, the final fiscal year for obligation is FY 1990 and the Project Assistance Completion Date is December 31, 1991.

DISCUSSION: Oral Rehydration Therapy (ORT) is one of the main components of the Agency's Child Survival Program. A.I.D. has expanded its activities in this field by strengthening ORT components of existing activities and by initiating new projects. This expansion has led to over 70 projects in some 50 A.I.D.-assisted countries.

This rapid expansion has created a need for continued and new information on diarrheal disease. The ORT-HELP project was flexibly designed to promote the exchange of information about ORT and to stimulate long-term planning among developing country leaders and health providers. The project has successfully completed over 20 subactivities ranging from a PASA with the Peace Corps, production of the ICORT II Proceedings, to support for an international newsletter on diarrheal disease control.

The focus of ORT-HELP activities during the proposed extension will continue to be oral rehydration therapy, a centerpiece of the Agency's Child Survival Action Program. The overall scope of activities will decline slightly in terms of average annual expenditures. During the extension, project support will increasingly emphasize the education and planning needs of the diarrheal disease control programs established since the project's inception. The project will also incorporate recent technical and programmatic advances in diarrheal disease control, such as preventive measures in hygiene and nutrition.

It is anticipated that additional funds in the amount of \$4,500,000 will be required to allow this project to continue its activities for three years beyond the original life of project period. This will permit the Agency to continue its work in information sharing and assistance in long-term planning and will allow the project to broaden its focus to other key child survival areas.

An Advice of Program Change is in the clearance process.

RECOMMENDATION: (1) That you approve the increase in Health funds and the addition of Child Survival Funds for expanded program activities; and (2) that you approve the increase in the LOP funding from \$4,800,000 to a new LOP amount of \$9,300,000; and (3) extend the LOP period from three years to six years by signing the amended project authorization attached.
