Dear Sirs:

Pursuant to the authority contained in the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, the Agency for International Development (hereinafter referred to as "AID" or "Grantor") hereby grants to the Asociación de Agricultores de Ica (hereby referred to as "AAI" or "Grantee"), the additional amount of \$40,000 to provide continuing support for a program in agricultural diversification, research, promotion and extension, as described in the Letter of Agreement dated June 17, 1986, Attachment 1 and 2 thereto and a Revised Schedule which are attached and made a part hereof (Attachment A for purposes of this amendment). This additional \$40,000 represents the last grant increment and supplements the \$10,000 previously granted for a cumulative total granted to date of \$50,000 (the "Grant").


This grant increment is effective and obligation is made as of the date of this letter and shall apply to commitments made by the Grantee in furtherance of program objectives during the period beginning with the effective date and ending March 31, 1987.

This Grant is made to AAI on condition that the funds will be administered in accordance with the terms and conditions as set forth in Attachment 1, entitled the "Schedule," Attachment 2, entitled "Program Description,"

Attachment 3, entitled "Mandatory Standard Provisions," Attachment 4 "Optional Standard Provision", of the Letter of Agreement dated June 17, 1986 and the Revised Schedule which have been agreed to by your organization.



SCHEDULE

A. Purpose:

The purpose of this Grant is to assist the Asociación de Agricultores de Ica (AAI) to continue and expand a program of private agricultural research and technology diffusion. This will be achieved through a set of activities to promote diversification of the Ica Valley into selected horticultural crops, to initiate a farm records/farm management program and to carry out studies required to determine economic viability of a long-term diversification plan.

These activities will permit this private producers association to continue and intensify its efforts in the generation of research information, diffusion of technology and provision of related services as a means of intensifying agricultural productivity, increasing incomes and capital formation for recapitalization of the sector.

B. Period of Grant:

1. The effective date of this Grant is June 17, 1986 and the expiration date is March 31, 1987.

2. Funds obligated hereunder are available for program expenditures for the estimated period June 17, 1986 to March 31, 1987, as shown in the Financial Plan below.

C. Amount of Grant and Payment:

1. The total estimated amount of this Grant for the period shown in B.1 above is \$50,000.

2. AID by Letter of Agreement dated June 17, 1986 obligated \$10,000 and hereby obligates the additional amount of \$40,000 for program expenditures during the period set forth in B.2 above and as shown in the Financial Plan below.

3. Payment shall be made to the Grantee in accordance with procedures set forth in Attachment 4, Optional Standard Provision 1, "Payment-Periodic Advance" of the original Letter Grant dated June 17, 1986.

4. Advances will be made under this grant upon liquidation of outstanding advances under previous grants.

D. Financial Plan:

The following is the Grant Budget including local cost financing items. Revisions to this Budget shall be made in accordance with Mandatory Standard Provision 4 of this Grant entitled "Revision of Grant Budget."

E. Reporting and Evaluation:

AAI agrees to provide USAID, Office of Agricultural and Rural Development with 3 copies of the following reports in Spanish:

1. Final report on implementation of Project activities within 30 days after the end of project period. This will include a discussion of achievement of goals.
2. Quarterly financial reports stating amounts of funds received, spent and liquidated by main line items of budget.
3. Reports prepared for any studies carried out under this Grant.

F. Special Provisions:

1. The authorized geographic code for procurement of goods and services under this Grant is AID Geographic Code 000 and Peru. Local currency financing also is authorized up to \$40,000 equivalent.

2. The Optional Standard Provisions, Attachment 4 for Non-U.S. Non-Governmental Grantees/AID Form 1420-54 (1-85) apply as follows:

- 1, Payment-Periodic Advance;
- 3, Air Travel and Transportation;
- 4, Ocean Shipment of Goods;
- 5, Procurement of Goods and Services;
- 6, Ineligible and Restricted Goods and Services;
- 8, Local Cost Financing with U.S. Dollars;
- 20, Cost Sharing.

3. For all purposes relevant to this Grant, Grantee will be represented by the President and Treasurer, who will delegate project implementation responsibilities to the individual holding or acting in the Office of the Manager of AAI, and AID will be represented by the individual holding or acting in the office of Mission Director, each of whom, by written notice, may designate additional representatives for all purposes except amending this Agreement.

The names of the representatives of the Grantee, with specimen signatures, will be provided to AID which may accept as duly authorized any instrument signed by such representatives in implementation of this Grant, until receipt of written notice of revocation of their authority.
