COMMODITY IMPORT GRANT AGREEMENT

Between

The Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan (Grantee) acting through the
Ministry of Planning

And

The United States of America, acting through the Agency for
International Development (AID).

WHEREAS, On September 17, 1985 the Grantee and AID
("Parties") entered into a Grant Agreement for Commodity Import
("Agreement") whereby AID granted to the Grantee Fifty Million
United States Dollars (\$50,000,000) to finance the Commodity
Import Program ("CIP"); and

WHEREAS, The Parties, on September 23, 1986 amended the said
Agreement to provide an additional Fifty Four Million Five Hundred
Forty-Eight Thousand and Eight Hundred United States Dollars
(\$54,548,800) for the purpose set out in the Agreement, and to
amend other provisions of said Agreement;

WHEREAS, the Parties now wish to amend the said Agreement,
as amended, to provide an additional One Million United States
Dollars (\$1,000,000).

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

1. Article 1: The Grant.

In the last sentence of Article 1., delete the Number "One
Hundred and Four Million Five Hundred Forty Eight Thousand Eight
Hundred United States Dollars (\$104,548,800) and substitute
therefore the number "One Hundred Five Million, Five Hundred
Forty-Eight Thousand, Eight Hundred United States Dollars
(\$105,548,800)".

2. Except as amended herein the Agreement dated September 17,
1985, as amended shall remain in full force and effect.
