AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE

THIS AMENDMENT is made between the Kingdom of Thailand ("Borrower"), acting through the Ministry of Finance, and the United States of America, acting through the Agency for International Development ("A.I.D.")..

WHEREAS on September 20, 1984, the Parties hereto entered into a Project Loan Agreement for the Agricultural Technology Transfer Project pursuant to which A.I.D. agreed to loan to the Borrower Four Million Five Hundred Thousand United States ("U.S.") Dollars (\$4,500,000) to finance certain foreign exchange and local currency costs of goods and services required for the project; and

WHEREAS A.I.D. is now prepared to make a further contribution to the Project in the amount of Two Million United States ("U.S.") Dollars (\$2,000,000);

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree that the Agreement shall be and hereby is amended as follows:



Section 3.1 of the Agreement is amended by deleting therefrom the words and number "Four Million and Five Hundred Thousand United States ("U.S.") Dollars (\$4,500,000)", and substituting therefor the words and number "Six Million Five Hundred Thousand United States ("U.S.") Dollars (\$6,500,000)".


Except as amended in accordance with the foregoing, the Agreement is ratified, confirmed and continued in full force and effect in accordance with its terms.

SUBJECT: Reobligation of Funds for Support of the Agricultural Technology Transfer (ATT) Project

Problem: Your approval is required to reobligate \$2,000,000 in loan funds for support of the ATT project.

Discussion: As a result of discussions between USAID, the MOF, NESDB and MOAC, it has been agreed to deobligate \$2,000,000 in loan funds from the Northeast Rainfed Agricultural Development (NERAD) project, and to reobligate these funds for support of the ATT project. The \$2,000,000 deobligation was executed on September 8, 1986.

The Congressional Notification for reobligation expired August 15, 1986. A new budget allowance has been received. The ATT Project Authorization has been amended to permit this increase of funds.

Recommendation: That you sign the enclosed Amendment No. 1 to the ATT Project Loan Agreement reobligating \$2,000,000.

1. Section 3.1 of the Agreement is amended by deleting therefrom the words and number "Five Hundred Thousand United States ("U.S.") Dollars (\$500,000)", and substituting therefor the words and number "One Million United States ("U.S.") Dollars (\$1,000,000)".

2. Annex 2 (Project Grant Standard Provisions) to the Agreement is hereby deleted in its entirety and Annex 2 in the form attached hereto is substituted in lieu thereof.

Except as amended in accordance with the foregoing, the Agreement is ratified, confirmed and continued in full force and effect in accordance with its terms.


