


AUTHORIZATION AMENDMENT



ACTION MEMORANDUM FOR THE AGENCY DIRECTOR FOR POPULATION

SUBJECT: Population Technical Assistance Project 936-3024 (Doc. No. 0020)

Action: Your approval is requested for an amended authorization to extend the duration of this project from two to seven years, and to increase the life of project funding from \$3,120,000 to \$13,000,000.

Discussion: The Population Technical Assistance Project was originally authorized on 3/5/84 for a period of ten years and later reduced to two years by an amended authorization on 4/10/84. A further amendment extended the final year of obligation from FY 85 to FY 86. A contract to implement the project was executed on 8/1/84 with the International Science and Technology Institute (ISTI) through the Small Business Administration and is scheduled to end 6/30/87.

Total obligations to date under the contract with ISTI are \$3,556,724, including \$1.3 million in buy-ins under mission and other AID/W bureau authorities.

The purpose of the project is to improve the effectiveness of population programs by providing short-term technical assistance services to public and private sector institutions to improve the design, implementation and management of population programs. The project provides expert consultants in response to specific requests for technical assistance in a broad spectrum of disciplines. The contractor has been responsive to AID's requirements and has administered consultant assignments to AID's satisfaction. Nearly 100 assignments have been undertaken and over 120 consultants have been recruited to provide technical assistance to 33 missions and 59 centrally funded projects. A registry of population experts has grown to nearly a thousand names and the system for consultant searches has become fully operational.

ISTI's performance to date has been consistent with its number one ranking in the technical competition for the contract. Because this project is an 8(a) set-aside with no requirement for competitive procurement, S&T/POP plans to request M/SER/OP/W/HP to negotiate a two year extension of the contract with ISTI to continue through August 1989. This is the maximum contract period allowed.

Further extension of the project authorization through FY 1991 will allow S&T/POP to plan for a new three year contract, presumably with an 8(a) firm, so as to avoid any gap in service. Experience with assignments handled by the ISTI contract indicate that scheduling must sometimes be completed up to two years in advance.

A ten-year project paper was approved in FY 1984; therefore review and approval of this action by the Population Sector Council is not required to complete the requested increase and extension. Nevertheless, comments were requested from S&T/POP Divisions, Regional Bureaus and Missions, and positive feedback was received. An Advice of Program Change is required and is in process.

Recommendation: That you approve the attached authorization amendment.
