


Problem: An extension of the Project Assistance Completion Date for the Low Cost Energy Technologies Project is necessary in order to extend VITA's contract at no-cost.

Discussion: VITA has requested a no-cost extension until December 31, 1987 in order to complete activities as outlined in the attached letter from VITA.

This extension is needed through no fault of VITA's. The Renewable Energy Data Base activity took longer than expected due to unanticipated difficulties in obtaining and correlating the necessary information. The training sessions for USAID and the private sector cannot be held until the data base is complete. The technology/application assessments (a review of technology priorities) has also been slow in being completed due to the same reason.

No additional funds will be necessary to complete these activities.

Recommendation: That you approve an extension of the Project Assistance Completion Date from June 30, 1987 to June 30, 1988 in order for VITA to complete the activities started under their original contract by signing below. VITA only requested an extension until December 31, 1987 but S&T/EY recommends an extension until June 30, 1988 to cover any other unanticipated developments.
